POINT OF INFORMATION

Shri Girdari Lal Raina, Hon'ble Member, raised the issue of taking over of National High School by the Government.

Shri Showkat Hussain Ganie, Hon'ble Member, raised issue regarding statement of Army Chief related to education setup of J&K and asked Government to come up with a statement in this behalf.

Shri Vikram Randhawa, Hon'ble Member, urged that holiday on account of Holi festival be observed on 2nd of March instead of 1st March, as per Hindu calendar.

Shri Sham Lal Baghat, Hon'ble Member, urged that there should be reservation for ladies of SC in Panchayats especially in Assar Block.

Shri Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Hon'ble Member, informed the House that Mr. Narinder Modi, is first Prime Minister ranked among top three Prime Ministers as per Gulf Survey and wanted that House should applause this.

Shri Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member, wanted the rationalization of reservation of SC/ST wards and Panchyats in Poonch and Rajouri.

CALLING ATTENTION

Mr. Zafer Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member to call the attention of the Government towards a matter of urgent public importance, namely, the situation that has arisen due to perpetual negligence to check the menace of uncontrolled and unchecked presence of stray dogs in Srinagar with special reference to Sanat Nagar/Rawalpora bye pass and surrounding areas, where the situation has gone from bad to worse due to clandestine dumping of garbage and waste food on the road side, exactly opposite GHSS Rawalpora, two hundred meters away from NHW, hence a grave threat to the lives of common people at large and the students in particular making them vulnerable to dog biting and various and steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

Ms. Asea Naqash, Hon'ble Minister of State for Health replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Members.
