POINT OF INFORMATION

Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganaie, Hon'ble Member requested the Chair to call back Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member who is on protest and Chair directed Mr. Saif-Ud-Din & Shri. Surinder Kumar Choudhary, Hon'ble Members to persuade him to join the proceedings of the House. The Hon'ble Member later joined the House.

QUESTION HOUR

Starred C.Q. Nos. 132, 87, 242 & Clubbed C.Q. No's (360, 43 & 484), 434, 55 & 414 were orally answered.

Starred C.Q. Nos. 196, 27, 370, 13, 79 & 285 and Un-Starred C.Q. Nos. 574, 412, 457, 556 & 17 were laid on the table of the House.

During the discussion of **Clubbed (C.Q.No.360, 43 & 484)** asked by **Shri. Ramesh Arora, Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone and Shri. Ajatshatru Singh** regarding Drug Menace, **Choudhary Lal Singh, Hon'ble Minister for Forest** informed the House if any one has any information regarding cultivation of Bang, that will be looked into. On this Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member stated that Bang is being cultivated in Kamraz Forest Division Lolab. Shri. Ajatshatru Singh requested for half and hour discussion which was supported by other Members also. Chair directed that let the Members move the application and same will be looked into.

In response to Starred **C.Q. No. 434** asked by **Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member** regarding the violations that took place while erecting palatial buildings/hotels at Pahalgam, Gulmarag and Sonamarag, Mrs. Priya Sethi, Hon'ble Minister of State for Tourism assured the House that norms will be followed at Sonamarag at par with Pahalgam and Gulmarag while dealing with the erection of Buildings/Hotels and violators will be dealt as per law. Chair also directed the Minister to look into the matter as violations are taking place. While intervening Mr. Ab. Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue informed that the matter is being monitoring by the Hon'ble High Court in the PIL and the Court Orders are being implemented in Letter and Spirit in this regard.

Chair today half an Hour discussion was listed under Rule-51 (1) on points arisen out of Starred C. Q. No. 402 taken up on 15 January, 2018, regarding Power Projects in District Kistiwari, As Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, In-charge Power is out of state, if it is feasible, may defer the same upto Monday. Noisy scene was witnessed. On this Syed. Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Minister for R&B stated since issue is of important nature and Minister concerned is out of state in some official work defer the discussion till Monday. Chair agreed.

Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member demanded reply from the government regarding yesterday's issue i.e. team to be sent to Wardwan area and cell to be open at District Hospital Anantnag as Hepatitis-B is at large in the area.

Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member raised the issue of recent Lolab fire victims and requested for their rehabilitation.

Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar, Hon'ble Member requested for completion of work of roads which were taken in hand in 2015 at Watpora Saitange and Shalina Seerbag.

Shri. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member raised the issue of Package to POK Refuges and also requested to include 568 families also in package who are living outside state. He further stated there are some lacunas in the wills of deceased persons required adoption be addressed.

Mr. Yasir Reshi, Hon'ble Member raised the issue regarding power Transformers of Sonawari area and requested these be get repaired as early as possible.

Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding mecamidazation plant which has been established on main road and due to its pollution people of village like Dardoo, Janana, Dranga, Chatlra, Rounda, Diggi, Seri, Gutasa, Neouta, Lamote and Tapri are suffering and requested to shift the plant to some isolated place.

Shri. Surinder Kumar Choudhary, Hon'ble Member informed the House shelling/ firing from across the border in Nowshera due to which education is being affected and requested to take reformative steps, he further stated that a decision has been taken to 2-Batalians for protection of people and requested that they should be installed in radius of 5-KMs inside of border .

Shri. Vikram Randwa, Hon'ble Member raised the issue regarding encroachment of JDA land by some persons.

Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member demanded that a team to be sent to Wardwan area and cell to be open at District Hospital Anantnag as Hepatitis-B is at large in the area.

On this Chair directed a team be sent by tomorrow and report be submitted on the same.

Shri. Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Hon'ble Member demanded enhancement of wages for skilled daily-wagers from Rs 450 to 600 who are working in cleaning Dal Lake.

Shri. Ajatshatru Singh, Hon'ble Member demanded to set up a Museum at Mubarkh Mandi to preserve the historical artefacts and valuables of Tosh-e-Khana. He said the valuable articles constitute a part of Dogra heritage and need to be preserved.

Mr. Mohammad Muzaffar Paray, Hon'ble Member raised an issue that plant genetics, Plant Psychology, Meteorology, Animal Science were not reflected in Budget and incentives of Serial Protection, Poultry, Mushroom and Dairy.

Shri. G. L. Raina, Hon'ble Member drew the attention of Government towards the dilapidated condition of JDA residential quarters at Nehru Market. He said there were high chances of an untowered incident and the residents should be relocated to safe location till the quarters get renovated.

Shri. Shamlal Bagat, Hon'ble Member demands allocation of funds for repair of irrigation canals in Asar funds and Jethi Nallas of Doda are which will help in enhancing the production in vegetable rich area and eventually help to boost the economy of the locals.

Mr. Javid Mirchal, Hon'ble Member demanded better and all-weather road connectivity to Karnah. He said the area remains cut off during winter season and causes immense sufferings to the local people. He demanded immediate construction of Sadna Tunnel to prevent loss of lives due to avalanche.

Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member demanded connecting of water schemes namely Mehjoor, Sheikhul Alam and Shamus Faqir to Sukhnag to end the water scarcity in these habitants.

Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member demanded medical aid for patient namely Mrs. Jameela W/o Late, Gaffar Najar Handwara and presently admitted at G.M.C Srinagar. He said the patient huge units of blood which should be provided to her without any delay.

Chair directed to look into it.

Shri. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member condemned the death of two civilians killed in yesterday firing incident from across the border. He also demanded resumption of the cross LOC bus through Chakein-de Bagh point which he said it has been suspended since many days due to cross border shelling.

Shri. Pradeep Sharma, Hon'ble Member demanded for extending the ALC category benefits to all border residents.

Mr. Khursheed Alam, Hon'ble Member drew attention of government towards the deteriorating condition of Sanic School Manasbal. He said lack of facilities is affecting the studies of the students. He demanded that proper teaching and medical facilities must be provided to the students.

S. Charanjeet Singh, Hon'ble Member raised an issue that D/O's provided by Legislator to Deputy Commissioners are not taken seriously.

Mr. Sofi Yousuf, Hon'ble Member demanded regularization of 36000 SPO's.

Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member demanded development of Keegam Tehsil on priority during current financial year.
