**The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11: 00 A.M.
(Hon'ble Chairman Haji Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

POINT OF INFORMATION

Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding the migration of 17000 civilians from LOC and International border due to cross border firing, who are now putting in camps and also the injured have been hospitalized and demanded a team of Members be nominated to visit the Hospitals and camps to have on spot assessment of the losses/ suffering to the people.

Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding non-seriousness of Print and Electronic Media in highlighting the issue of Asifa's rape and murder.

On this Chair expressed his dismay over the negligence of highlighting important issues of this House by Media and stated that directions have been passed 2-times for the same but nothing has been done from their side so far. And also directed **Syed. Altaf Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Education** to look into it.

Mr. Mohd. Altaf Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Education made a statement in this regard and said that the concern of House have been noted and the directions will be passed to information department and hope this will not happen in future.

Mr. Qasier Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member demanded a statement from government regarding the list of Casual Labours circulated on Internet/ Social Media.

Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member demanded ½ Hour discussion regarding issue of firing at the Border.

Mrs. Shehnaz Ganie, Hon'ble Member demanded statement from Government regarding the steps taken by them for the displaced people of border areas due to firing incidents across the border as people are living in a shadow of death.

Mr. Sajjad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member sought Government's attention towards the news item published in today's Daily Excelsior regarding the most corrupt departments of the State by the S.V.C.

Sofi Yousuf, Hon'ble Member also **staged a Walk-out** from the House for not being allowed to raise supplementary to the Question.

- (i) **Shri Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the problems faced by Home guards and their families because of the meager salary (Rs. 1250/-only) and day to day price hike and the steps taken to enhance their salary to lessen their miseries.

Minister for Agriculture, Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

- (ii) **Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to frequent accidents which occur on Sadhna Tanghdar road causing deaths.

Minister for Agriculture, Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and assured the House that work on the said road will be started soon.

- (iii) **Shri Surinder Choudhary, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to non-availability of any mechanism with the government to check prices of the essential commodities in the State.

Minister for CA&PD, Choudhary Zulfikar Ali replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and desired that 1/2-hour discussion be held on the same.
