BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11: 00 A.M.
(Hon'ble Chairman Haji Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

As soon as the House assembled for today's Business, all the Hon'ble Members from opposition were on their feet demanding adjournment of **Question Hour** and constituting of House Committee regarding **Power Projects in District Kishtwar**.

Chair allowed **Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member** to speak, **Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member** stated that since this is an important issue as the people of Kishtwar are on protest and as such, demanded constitution of House Committee, **Chair** tried to pacify the Opposition Members and asked them to raise their issues after the Question Hour, but they continued with their protest, While intervening **Mr. Ab. Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Parliamentary Affairs** stated that let they take their respective seats and raise their issues one by one but Members from Opposition continued with their protest.

In the mean time **Shri. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding worsening situation in the Border areas due to cross border firing in which several civilians including domestic animals were killed and several vehicles damaged and demanded statement from Government in this regard.

Shri. Surinder Kumar Choudhary, Hon'ble Member demanded establishment of individual and community banker for the people of border areas putting in camps and also demanded relaxation to the students whose studies were affected due to cross border firings.

Mr. Ab. Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Parliamentary Affairs made a statement that government is fully aware regarding the situation on the Border and almost all the Ministers have visited camps, the preventive measure and compensation paid to the effected families as also has been stated in the Lower House. Hon'ble Minister further said that the Government is directly in a reconciliation process. It is a fact that whenever cross border firing incidents take place, people of J&K especially those living on the borders suffer and the Government is taking necessary steps for their Rehabilitation. GOI has provided funds for establishment of bankers and all the necessary steps will be taken to ensure safety of the people.

Chair allowed Question Hour and asked **Shri. Yashpal Sharma, Hon'ble Member** to raise his question.
