POINT OF INFORMATION

Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member raised an issue for constituting a House Committee regarding **Power Projects in District Kishtwar** and demanded Rehabilitation, Compensation and Employment to the affected people of Chenab Valley.

On this, **Chair** responded to the Hon'ble Members that this House has earlier in 2016 constituted 3-House Committees but the report of these Committees have not been submitted to the Legislative Council Secretariat till date which is mandatory as per the Rules of Procedure & conduct of Business in J&K Legislative Council. The **Chair** conveyed that all Hon'ble Members who are heading and associated with House Committees should furnish the report of these Committees and only then the request of constituting House Committee on the said issue will be considered.

While intervening during the course of replies to Clubbed C.Q. No's (44, 535 & 553)

Asked by **Mr. Qaisr Jamsheed Lone, Shri. Pradeep Sharma & Shri. Yashpal Sharma, Hon'ble Members** regarding steps taken by the State/ Central Government to protect the lives and property of people living near LOC by cross border shelling /firing, **Hon'ble Chief Minister, Ms. Mehbooba Mufti** pitched for good Indo-Pakistan relations and hoped that Pakistan will follow **Prime Minister, Narendra Modi's** advice and jointly fight poverty and focus on development rather than fighting with each other on borders and stated that it is shameful and unfortunate that bunkers need to be constructed when the world has moved far ahead but we are going back to stone age. Pakistan and India have common problems like poverty and Development, but our heads hang in the shame, when we have to provide bunkers and bullet proof ambulances instead of good schools and Hospitals. She further said that fighting poverty together is the way forward rather than fighting each other and using energies to destroy each other. She further stated that we can build Bunkers and save our lives but can't compensate to the children who lost their education. She further stated that the issue will be taken with the **Home Minister of India. Hon'ble Chief Minister** concluded her speech with the statement that construction of bunkers is a temporary solution not a permanent one to the issue.
