BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11: 00 A.M.

POINT OF INFORMATION

Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo , Hon'ble Member demanded suspension of Question Hour in lieu of Adjournment Motion on the recent killings in Shopian to raise the discussion on the issue as has been done in Lower House. **Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member** also supported the move for discussing the issue.

Shri. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member demanded a probe into the death of a child at Rehabilitation/ Drug-de-addiction Center Rajouri.

In response **Shri. Bali Bhagat, Hon'ble Minister for Health & Medical Education** stated that since the Rehabilitation/ Drug-de-addiction center is run by some NGO's and not directly by the health department, however he assured that the matter will be investigated.

Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding twin deaths occurred in last two days in the Wardwan Kishtiwari suspected by Hepatitis-B and requested for direction from **Chair** and assurance by Government for investigation, and said that people of the area are in a state of shock/ fear and the report submitted by C-M-O is not basis on facts.

On this the Chair directed the Hon'ble Minister for Health & Medical Education to look into the matter and take the necessary steps on priority.

While responding to the Chair **Shri. Bali Bhagat, Hon'ble Minister for Health & Medical Education** stated that two persons have died during last two days, namely Parveena Bano, D/O Mohammad Rajab, 16-years old girl due to head injuries after falling down from her house and Khatona Begum, 65 years old due to Brain Tumor ailing from past two years.

Mr. Yasir Reshi, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding delay in operating a patient namely Khateeja, hospitalized in SKIMS Bemina, Srinagar in Ward no-01, Bed no-04 from the last 20-days.

Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member demanded for providing free medicines to the persons injured in an accident occurred at Kara Ganduh, and Doda Road in which 3-persons died and 52 were injured.

Shri. Bali Bhagat, Hon'ble Minister for Health and Medical Education responded that necessary directions will be passed to Medical Superintendent, Doda in this regard and whatever is possible will be done as a special case .

Shri. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member demanded action against C-M-O/ Medical Superintendent Udampur for not providing Ambulance to shift a pregnant lady namely: - Sushma Devi from Chenani to Udampur Hospital.

Hon'ble Chairman allowed the Adjournment Motion moved by the Opposition and suspension the Question Hour to hold the discussion on the Shopian Killings.

CALLING ATTENTION

- (i) **Mr. Sajjad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to death of one Kuldeep Singh S/o Chakandar Lal R/o Sazar Padder District Kishtwar on 14-10-2017 as a result of landslide. Reasons for not granting ex-gratia relief to next kin/s of the deceased till date and steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

Minister for Education, Mr. Mohammad Altaf Bukhari replied the points raised by **the Hon'ble Member**.

- (ii) **Shri Surinder Choudhary, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to non-availability of basic facilities in the Health Centers situated on the border.

Minister for Health, Shri. Bali Bhagat replied the points raised by the **Hon'ble Member**.

- (iii) **Shri Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to delay in introducing more subjects as required, which has created confusion among the recent pass out students waiting for the decision in order to get the admission in 10+2 and action taken to address the issue before expiry of last date of admissions.
