**The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11: 00 A.M.
(Hon'ble Chairman, Haji Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

11:00 Hrs. POINT OF INFORMATION

Shri. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member demanded for observance of two minutes silence in respect of an Officer, three Army Personnel and some civilians who died in yesterday's across Border shelling in Poonch and also demanded that a Resolution be moved in this behalf.

Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member also demanded to move a Resolution regarding killings due to cross border firing and also demanded statement by the Government regarding yesterday's All Party Meeting for Panchayat Elections in view of publication of different version in the news papers on the subject.

Shri. Surinder Mohan Ambardar & Shri. G. L. Raina Hon'ble Members referred the Daily Excelsior News Paper, dated 3rd of February issued in respect of appointment of Stenographers and Typists under P. M. Package in view of inclusion of suspected fake candidates.

Shri. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member demanded for probe into the statement of former CM regarding Hyper Nationality on the incidence of Mehander Garh and demanded debate for the same.

Calling Attention

(I) Shri Sham Lal Bhagat, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the non-availability of Government Degree College within Doda and Ramban District Headquarters and the steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture, Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone replied the points raised by the **Hon'ble Member**.

(ii) Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance, namely, the situation that has arisen due to problems faced by the people of Leh who are getting hardly 4 to 5 hours power supply despite Having 42 MW Nimo - Basgo Power Project which is supposed to supply 24 hour power supply to the consumers and the steps taken by the **Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture, Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone** replied the points raised by the **Hon'ble Member**.
