**Point Of Information**

**Showkat Hussain Gaine:** - raised the issue of repeated harassment to students of the State at Haryana and said that second incident took place during the current week.

On this **Mr. Sajad Gani Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Social Welfare** informed that the FIR have been lodged in this behalf by Haryana Police and Government have taken cognizance of it.

Not satisfied with reply from the Government **Hon'ble Members from N.C joined by Mr. G. N. Monga** from Congress staged **walk-out**.

**Point Of Information**

**Mr. Saif-Ud-Din, Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Mr. Khursheed Alm, Shri. Surinder Kumar Choudhary** demanded statement from **Hon'ble Minister for Social Welfare** which he made in Lower House regarding consulting of M.L.A's only and not M.L.C's in various schemes of the department and demanded inclusion of MLC's also to play positive role for implementing these Schemes.

**Mr. Sajad Gani Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Social Welfare** informed that MLA's are elected candidates who are chosen by majority of the people and therefore are having knowledge if the deserving people to be considered under different Social Welfare Schemes for providing benefits under the norms. However the consultation of Hon'ble MLC can be considered by having consensus after due deliberations.

1. **Shri. Shamlal Bhagat** demanded construction of Fruit Mandi in Asar, Kandari Nallah area being far flung area.
2. **Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar** raised an issue regarding inclusion of Casual/ Seasonal employees for regularization list whose qualification is below 8<sup>th</sup> standard and also demanded inclusion of employees whose age is above 60 years.
3. **Shri. Vibod Gupta** demanded shifting of Ammunition Depo from Municipality limits of Rajouri.

**Choudhary Zulfikar Ali, Hon'ble Minister for FCS&CA** on this assured the House that same will be taken up with Defense Ministry and hopefully it will be resolved, since this is an important issue.

4. **Shri. Pradeep Sharma** raised issue of up-gradation of high school at Gallas Poonch.
5. **Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat** demanded re-naming the Industrial area Krimshora Khanshab instead of Kachwari .
6. **Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo** demanded financial help to be provided to the saffron growers of Pampore and Kishtiwari.
7. **Mr. G. N. Monga** demanded promotions for M.B.B.S doctors at par with JE's.
