The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11:00 Hrs

(Hon'ble Chairman Mr. Jahangir Hussain Mir in the Chair)

11: 00 Hrs As soon as the House assembled for today's Business, Hon'ble Members from opposition trooped into well and started protesting against alleged discrimination over allocation of funds for transformer bank.

Hon'ble Chairman requested them to take their seats and raise the issue after Question Hour. As there was den in the House Hon'ble Chairman adjourned the House for 10 minutes.

1. Mr. Jugal Kishore, Hon'ble Member demanded early renovation of old hospital Reasi for making it functional to provide health care facilities to the people of the area at their doorsteps. He also urged for inquiry into misappropriation of relief for Reasi.

2. S. Dharambir Singh Oberio, Hon'ble Member demanded early conduct of Gurdarwara Prabandhak Committee (GPC) elections in the State.

3. Mr. Vibodh Gupta, Hon'ble Member demanded inter district recruitment and pleaded for early release of salary of RET (SSA) teachers.

4. Dr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri, Hon'ble Member pleaded for bringing transparency in transfer policy of the employees. He also demanded transfer of over staying teachers at Leh.

5. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member demanded air dropping of essential commodities for landslide prone areas of Bhalessa, Charala Kalotran, Gundu, Barfi, Chillia, Chanta, Sandra, Gudaka, Badrawah, Goda and other effected areas of Doda district. He also urged for airlifting of Doda Kishtiwari stranded passengers.

6. Javid Ahmad Mirchal, Hon'ble Member highlighted deteriorated conditions of roads in his constituency and demanded an immediate repairs of these roads including Sangri road, besides he also demanded for up-gradation and alternate road connectivity.

7. Surinder Choudhary, Hon'ble Member raised the issue of closing of border fencing gate by the Army and pleaded for taking of the issue with army so that specific timing is fixed for allowing farmers to carry out agriculture activities.

8. Sajjad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member asked for directions to be issued to local administration for assessment of losses due to inclement weather in affected areas of the State.

9. Dr. Shenaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member urged upon the government to make alternate arrangement for people of low-lying areas of Khaneter and Choomber Kanali in Poonch district to some safer place in view of ongoing rains and floods. She also demanded compensation and free ration to the affected people.

10. Mr. Gh. Nabi Monga, Hon'ble Member pleaded for early filling of posts of Public prosecutor in district Session Court in District Baramullah.

11. Mr. Sham Lal, Hon'ble Member demanded compensation for farmers whose vegetables crops has been damaged due to landslides/rains in Sudhmahadev in Chenani. He also asked immediate repair of irrigations khuls.

12. Mr. Qaiser Jamshed Lone, Hon'ble Member demanded early release of salary of Sakashar Bharat Mission teachers.

13. Mr. Showkat Ahmad Ganie, Hon'ble Member demanded for replacement of damaged transformers in Wachi Constituency .

14. Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member urged for posting of adequate medical staff in hospitals of Padder, Marwah and wardwan and other remote and far flung areas of Kishtiwari .

15. **Haji Anayat Ali, Hon'ble Member** demanded up gradation of Hospitals of Drass Kargil.

16. **Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar, Hon'ble Member** demanded for regularization of casual Laborers.

17. **Mr. Master Noor Hussain, Hon'ble Member** urged for upgradation of road connectivity and drinking water facility in Gujjar bakerwals habitations in Samba.

18. **Mr. Yashpal Sharma, Hon'ble Member** pleaded for expediting work on Sub-University Campus at Poonch and demanded relief to the farmers whose crops were damaged due to incessant rains in Poonch.

19. **Mr. Charanjeet Singh, Hon'ble Member** urged for checking overloading in trucks and passenger vehicles on National High Way.

ii) **Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to delay in completion of Sub-District Hospital building at Sogam, Lolab.

Mr. Ab. Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

iii) **Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to non-construction of collapsed foot Bridge over Nalla Hallayan Nagar, Bhadawarh, connecting Administration Complex, Court Complex, Schools, Police Stations and dense population. Due to non-construction, unrest prevailing among the public may cause law and order issue in the town.
