(Brief Record Of Proceedings)

The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11:00 Hrs

(Hon'ble Chairman Mr. Amrit Malhotra in the Chair)

11: 00 Hrs As soon as the House assembled Hon'ble Members from opposition protested and stated that Hon'ble Finance Minister did not reply the points regarding Panchayat institutions. While responding Mr. Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister, for Law and Parliamentary Affairs informed the House that meeting of Business Advisory Committee is being held today to discuss the business to be taken and discussion on working of Ministry for Rural Development will be given preference, Hon'ble Members can put forth their views during the discussion on the working of Ministry Rural Development and Panchayat Raj. However not satisfied some of the Members staged a walk out.

11:12Hrs **Question Hour**

Starred C.Q.Nos.360,258, 02,346,133,187, 330 and 326 were orally answered.

While replying to Starred C.Q.No.326 asked by Mr. Charanjit Singh, Hon'ble Member regarding Roshni Act. Hon'ble Minister, for Revenue Mr. Javid Mustafa Mir informed the House that the complaints regarding encroachment of state land will be solved on the priority basis.

Starred C.Q. Nos. 14, 118, 49,239, 30,155 and Unstarred C.Q.Nos175, 252,164, 273, 144, 196 and 42 were laid on the table of the House.

12:10Hrs **(Mr. Jehangir Hussain Mir Hon'ble Vice Chairman in Chair)**

Mr. Sajjad Ahmad Kichloo Hon'ble Member informed that Power Supply in Kishtwar has not been restored which was snapped due to recent rains although Government was committed to restore it by 24th.

Some other Hon'ble Members also showed their concern regarding Power shortage and other related problems. On this Mr. Mohammad Ashraf, Minister of State for Power assured the House that Power supply will be restored.

CALLING ATTENTION

(i) Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to heavy rainfall leading to closure of Batote-Kishtwar highway and inter-district roads in Chenab Valley, power breakdown in twin districts of Doda and Kishtwar and huge loss to the public and Government properties.

Hon'ble Minister for R&B, Mr. Altaf Ahmad Bukhari replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

(ii) Mr. Sham Lal Bhagat, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the Government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to sinking of land in the Villages of Seeti, Kolthun, Assar, Korapuri, Trungal and Kasha from Chanderkote upto Pul-Doda due to the water body which came into being as a result of construction of Bhagliar hydroelectric project.

Hon'ble Minister for Forests, Mr. Bali Baghat replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

(iii) Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the Government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to recent devastating rains and snow in the state resulting into damages to crops, property etc.

Mr. Basharat Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Relief, Law & Parliamentary Affairs, replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.
