The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11:00 Hrs

As soon as the House assembled for today's Business, Hon'ble Members from opposition were on their feet and were protesting regarding the current prevailing situation that has arisen due to harsh rains and floods in J&K especially in Kashmir Valley.

Hon'ble Chairman tried to pacify the agitated Members and requested them to take their seats and raise the issue after Question Hour. Meanwhile **Mr. Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Law and Parliamentary Affairs** said that this being serious issue of the Government will make a statement in the House. Not satisfied the opposition Members staged a walk out.

(BILLS FOR CONSIDERATION AND RETURN)

i) On behalf of **Mr. Haseeb A. Drabu, Hon'ble Minister for Finance, Mr. Pawan Kumar Gupta, Minister of State for Finance** moved that:-

“A Bill to authorize payment and Appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Jammu and Kashmir State for the services of Financial Year 2014-15 (L.A Bill No. 1 of 2015) as passed by the Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly be taken into consideration”.

Mr. Zulafker Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CAPD seconded the Bill.

The Bill was considered by voice vote.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Minister of State for Finance moved that the Bill be returned.

The Bill was adopted and returned to Legislative Assembly.

ii) **Mr. Pawan Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Minister of State for Finance** moved that:-

“A Bill to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Jammu and Kashmir State for the services of the Financial year 2015-16 (L.A Bill No. 2 of 2015) as passed by the Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly be taken into consideration”.

Mr. Zulafker Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CAPD seconded the Bill.

The Bill was considered by voice vote.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Minister of State for Finance moved that the Bill be returned to Legislative Assembly.

The Bill was adopted and returned to Legislative Assembly.

Mr. Jugal Kishore, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to the non release of ration to the inhabitants of Panchayat Sadhota, Badhota and Galale of Block Panchari during the last three months and also the reasons thereof

Mr. Zulafker Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CAPD replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

i) **Dr. Shehnaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** to call the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to non reduction of passenger fare by the transport operators.

Mr. Abdul Gani Kohli, Hon'ble Minister for Transport replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

ii) **Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to frequent road blocks on national highway only link to Kashmir with rest of India, as to why government is caught napping forcing thousands of commuters to suffer on this account, why government shall not arrange temporary shelters at various places to shift the stranded people as and when the situation arises.

On behalf of Minister for R&B, **Mr. Abdul Gani Kohli, Hon'ble Minister for Transport** replied the points raised by the **Hon'ble Member** and assured to the Hon'ble Member that his suggestions regarding constructing of temporary shelters at various places will be considered.

The Council was adjourned to meet again on **Wednesday 1st, of April 2015 at 11 am.**
