(Brief Record Of Proceedings)

The Council met in the Council Hall, Jammu at 11:00Hrs

(Hon'ble Chairman ShriAmritMalhotra in the Chair)

11:00Hrs

At the start of the proceedings, Several Members stood up from their seats and raised issue of people stranded at Jammu on this Hon'ble chairman directed Hon'ble Members to take their seats and raise the issue after Question Hour.

Starred C.Q.Nos.

362, 124, 240, 184, 53, 3, 327, 240, 152, 263,134, 184, 335 and 32 were orally answered.

While replying to Stared **C.Q.No.362** asked by **Shri. Ajay Kumar Sadhotra**, Hon'ble Member regarding gas pipeline,**Shri.Zulfkar Ali**, **Hon'ble Minister for CAPD** assured the House that as and when land is acquired, the work will be started.

While replying to stared**C.Q. No.124** asked by **Shri. Ali Mohammad Dar**, **Hon'ble Member** regarding National Health Mission Project,**ShriChowdrayLal Singh**, **Hon'ble Minister for Health** informed the House that the project would be completed within the time frame.

While replying to **C.Q.No.327** asked by **Shri. Charanjeet Singh** regarding establishing of Park at Gharanan (R.S Pora),**ShriGh. Nabi Lone**, **Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture** (on behalf of **Hon'ble Chief Minister**) informed the House that public Park would be established at Gharanan (R.S Pora).

While replying to **C.Q.No.134** asked by **Shri. Jugal Kishore Sharma** regarding construction of Multi Storied Buildings, **Dr. Nirmal Singh** informed the House that the directions of **Hon'ble High Court** will be implemented.

Starred C.Q.No.10 and UnstarredC.Q.Nos. 189, 267, 161, 139, 336, 16, 43 and 171 were laid on the table of the House.

Zero Hour

The following Hon'ble Members raised various issues during Zero Hour.

Shri.Sajjad Ahmad Kichloo raised the issue regarding blockage of National Highway due to damage caused by rains.

Shri.Jehangir Hussain Mir requested that relief be provided to the families whose houses were damaged due to landslide in Poonch.

Dr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri raised the issue regarding stranded people who are facing tremendous hardships at Jammu due to closure of National Highway.

Shri.Jugal Kishore Sharma raised the issue regarding the damage caused to the farmers due to the recent heavy rains and requested that their problems be redressed.

Shri.Sham Lal Bhagat raised the issue of damage caused to the houses in Chenab Valley due to recent rains.

Shri.Yasir Reshi raised the issue of rehabilitation of 100 families of Ganatan Village of Sonawari whose houses have been damaged due to recent flood.

Shri.Firdous Ahmad Tak raised the issue of 25 families whose houses were collapsed during the recent heavy rains in Kishtwar and requested that they may be shifted to safer places.

Dr. Shahnaz Ganai raised the issue of death of 18 year old girl due to land slides and damage caused to crops at Poonch.

Shri.Ghulam Nabi Moonga raised the issue of affected families of Laridorian area caused by recent heavy rains and erosion.

12.12 Hrs: (Hon'ble Chairman Shri Amrit Malhotra in the Chair)

Shri.Qaiser Jamshed Lone raised the issue regarding disruption of Power Supply due to recent rains and heavy snow falling in Lolab, Kupwara and Machil & requested that government should restore the power supply.

Shri.Ajay Kumar Sadhotra raised the issue regarding the damage caused to the crops due to heavy rains and yellow rust and requested the government to provide relief to the affected farmers.

Shri.Naresh Kumar Gupta raised the issue regarding shortage of essential commodities in Thatri and other hilly areas and requested the government should redress the problems of the people.

Sofi Mohammad Yousof raised the issue regarding the re-verification of the families whose House were partially/fully damaged during the September floods and requested that Government should take immediate steps to resolve their grievances.

Shri.Yashpal Sharma raised the issue regarding the damage caused to the bridges by the September floods and requested that government should construct the bridges at an earliest.

Shri.Vibod Gupta raised the issue regarding damage caused due to the September floods.

Reponding to the demands raised by Hon'ble member during Zero Hour **Hon'ble Minister for Education & leader of House Shri Naeem Akhtar Andarbi assured the House** that necessary instructions to redress there will be issued on priority basis.

Dr. Shenaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to non availability of basic facilities like safe drinking water and toilet facilities, in the government schools/educational institutions in the State.

Syed Naeem Akhter Hon'ble Minister for Education replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Members.
