

**CALLING ATTENTION NOTICE TABLED BY MR. SAJAD AHMAD KICHLOO, HON'BLE MLC.**

**"To call the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to road accident near Chatroo as a result nine Officials including Officers of Sheep Husbandry Department died and what steps taken for appointment of their Kith and Kin on Compassionate grounds".**

**REPLY:**

On the fateful day of 8<sup>th</sup> July 2014 a team of officers and staff members of Sheep Husbandry Department headed by Dr. Rafiq Ahmad Akhooon I/c District Sheep Husbandry Officer Kishtwar proceeded to Sinthan Top area to look into a suspected outbreak of disease in livestock of Gujjar and Bakerwals, in a vehicle bearing No. JK17-0840. While proceeding towards the location, the said vehicle plunged into deep gorge at Kamrazi Morh, Potato Farm near Sinthan Top at around 10.00 a.m. All the nine staff members died in the accident on spot.
