2. CALLING ATTENTION

- i) **Mr. Sofi Yousuf, Hon'ble Member** to call the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to absence of the bridge over Nallah Sandran at village Rathergund which connects village Gorinar & its adjoining areas like Gujjar Basti Brannad, Taki Bal and Khak Bal to Tehsil Headquarter Verinag in Dooru Constituency and the steps taken in this regard.
- ii) **Mr. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member** to call the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to disparity in diet charges paid to inmates of Pahari and Gujjar Bakerwal Hostels. iv) **Mr. Ghulam Nabi Monga, Hon'ble Member to move:-**


“This August House resolves that the railway link constructed up to Baramulla be extended up to Kupwara with a view to enhance the employment opportunities and connectivity of this backward area”
