REGARDING WIDENING OF ROAD

180. *(C. Q. No. 11) Shri Mohammad Muzaffar Parray : Will the Government be pleased to state what steps are being taken in respect of widening of road from Haigam, Tarzoova and Sopore which may be an alternate road to Sangrama, Sopore road ?

REGARDING CONSUMPTION OF POWER

181. *(C. Q. No. 283) Dr. Shehnaz Ganai : Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) the statistical details in terms of percentage of power consumption in the State, like domestic (rural, urban) commercial, State Government, Central Government, T&D losses etc. ;

(b) the steps being taken by the Government to check the losses ;

(c) number of BPL beneficiaries covered in the State under RGGVY in percentage and leftover during the last three years with special reference to District Poonch ;

(d) the steps being taken by the Government to start the 2nd Phase of RGGVY in the State ;

(e) the steps being taken for realignment of 132 KV Draba Transmission Line as the same gets damaged during rainy season ?

(b) if the reply to part (a) is in affirmative, please include—

- (i) the list of the persons including the sitting Legislators, Political Leaders/Workers, bureaucrats and other to whom the J&K Police Security Wing has provided the security cover and the vehicles as on date with category-wise criteria ;
- (ii) provide the list of Political Leaders/Workers with their party affiliation other than the MLAs/MLCs, Ex. MLAs/ Ex. MLCs ;
- (iii) provide norms being adopted by the Security Wing of the J&K Police for identification of persons to provide them security cover ;
- (iv) provide the monthly expenditure on the security provided to the leaders/bureaucrates or ex. bureaucrats including the salary to the security personals ;

- (v) provide the criteria of manpower and vehicles to the sitting Legislators ?

- (i) the district-wise list of VDC members presently operating ;
- (ii) is it also a fact that Government has issued arms to some youth in Kishtwar, Doda, Jammu and Rajouri townships (despite huge security presence) on the pattern of VDC members ; if so, the details thereof ;
- (iii) the details of monthly wages being paid to these VDC members and the mode of payment ;
