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REGARDING RMSA AND SSA SCHEMES

50. *(C. Q. No.157) Shri Ghulam Nabi Monga : Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) is it a fact that the flagship schemes RMSA & SSA are under implementation in the State ;

(b) how many students have been benefited under these two schemes ;

(c) whether the Government is contemplating a change in existing Education Policy ;

(d) whether the Government is going to implement the Right to Education Act ?

(Minister for Education).

REGARDING DUL HASTI POWER PROJECT

51. *(C. Q. No.237) Shri Firdous Ahmad Tak : Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) whether the Dul Hasti Power Project has been executed under an agreement with the State Government by NHPC, will the Government please reveal the terms and condition entered with NHPC with regard to this project ;

(b) is it a fact that the NHPC was under obligation to ensure Catchment Area Development near the Dam site in Dool during the construction of the project, if the answer is in affirmative, please submit the

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list of the work and persons allotted the work under the Catchment Area Development and the amount spent thereof ;

(c) is it also fact that NHPC is under obligation to contribute in the local area development under corporate social responsibility, if the answer is in affirmative, the list of the work and persons in favour of whom the works have been allotted under CSR by NHPC ;

(d) is the NHPC paying 12 per cent of the royalty out of its profits on the project to Jammu and Kashmir Government, if the answer is in affirmative, the amount paid to the State Government so far ;

(e) is the State Government under obligation to spent 2 per cent of the aforesaid amount on the local area development, if yes, the total amount made available by the NHPC to the State Government and list of the work undertaken under this particular head ?

REGARDING PROVIDING OF BOATS

52. *(C. Q. No. 5) Mr. Bashir Ahmad Magrey :

Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) is it a fact that a huge life/property loss was caused to people due to shortage of boats during the recent floods as also could not reach the safer places in time ;

(b) if yes, does the Government intend to reserve 100 boats at each District Headquarters, so that the people may not face more difficulties during floods in future ?

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REGARDING CONSTRUCTION OF ZOJILA TUNNEL

53. *(C. Q. No. 48) Haji Anayat Ali : Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) the status of construction of Zojila Tunnel, has the State Government taken-up the matter with concerned Ministry for its early construction ;

(b) if yes, when the execution of work on this tunnel will start ?

REGARDING PHCS AND ALLOPATHIC DISPENSARIES

54. *(C. Q. No. 117) Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar : Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) how many PHC and Allopathic Dispensaries have been sanctioned in District Budgam during the financial year 2014-2015 ;

(b) village-wise details of all the new sanctioned PHCs and Allopathic Dispensaries in District Budgam ;

(c) how many of these have been made operational during financial year 2014-2015 ;

(d) number of PHCs and Allopathic Dispensaries which have not been made operational yet and when are these expected to be made operational ?

REGARDING ILLEGAL OCCUPATION OF LAND

55. *(C. Q. No. 366) Shri Ajay Kumar Sadhotra :
Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) is it a fact that 1312 Kanals and 19 Marlas of land under Khasra Nos. 207, 208, 209 and 210 of Village Bhatoor, Tehsil Marh, District Jammu is under illegal occupation of influential persons ;

(b) will the Government please provide a list of illegal occupants on the above said land in respect of Khasra Nos. 207, 208, 209 and 210 ;

(c) what is the total number of standing trees on 1312 Kanals and 19 Marlas of land on the above said Khasra numbers at Village Bhatoor along with their species ;

(d) has the Revenue Department marked the trees ;

(e) does the Government intend to mark the trees on the said land also ;

(f) has the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu ordered demarcation of 1312 Kanals and 19 Marlas land of Gajansoo Joint Farming Co-operative Society Limited, Block Marh vide No. DCJ/SQ/Demarcation/Co-SOC/2014-15/4046-47 dated 30-10-2014, measuring 1312 Kanals and 19 Marlas ;

(g) when the said demarcation shall be completed ?

REGARDING LAND COMPENSATION

Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) whether there is huge liability towards the Government on account of land compensation for the land acquired for public purposes by the Works Department and other departments ;

(b) how much amount on account of compensation is needed in erstwhile Doda District especially to Collector, LA, Bhaderwah-Bhellesa-Thathri, please provide details ;

(c) how much amount is lying with the Collectors of the Land Acquisition throughout the State and reasons for non-disbursement ;

(d) what steps are being taken by the Government to clear the liability of land compensation, which has stalled the progress of the road construction ?

(c) how much evacuee land is under the illegal possession of various persons where the unauthorized residential/commercial constructions are going on and what steps the Government is going to take for vacation of such encroachments ?
