REGARDING ESTABLISHMENT OF CAFETERIAS

158. *(C. Q. No. 103) Shri Sofi Yousuf : Will the Government be pleased to state :—

(a) what is the total number of cafeterias and public conveniences of JKTDC on the route Bijbehara to Pahalgam and Khanabal to Pahalgam road ;
