**"This House resolves that due to disturbed condition in
the State, five marlas of land be allotted to the persons
living near International Border and Line of Control"**

Reply:

The State Cabinet vide decision No.180/13/2014 dated 10-10-2014 has already decided for providing five marlas of land per family in relatively safer zones, adjacent to their present villages, to the people affected due to cross border and cross LoC firing in the State. Accordingly in pursuance of the said Cabinet Decision the Divisional Commissioner Jammu has already been advised to prepare comprehensive proposal for rehabilitation of the affected families and submit the same to the Government for consideration. Since nearly 50000 families are affected detailed exercise in this regard is being carried out by the field agencies regarding identification of suitable land, financial implications involved etc.

Since a policy framework in this regard is already in place there is no further requirement to adopt the said resolution. The Hon'ble Member is accordingly requested to withdraw his resolution.
