"This August House resolves that in view of ever increasing pressure from within and across Pir-Panjal ranges and Chenab valley areas over secondary health care system of South Kashmir, especially district Anantnag, an AIIMS like medical institute may be built and developed in Anantnag, Kashmir, which will also decrease pressure over tertiary centers in Summer Capital of State, Srinagar"

Reply:-

Establishment of AIIMS is a prerogative of Central Government. The Central Government has made budget announcement during the presentation of budget for 2015-16 for establishment of AIIMS institute in Kashmir valley.


In addition to this, the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare announced five Medical Colleges in the State of J&K to be established at Kathua, Rajouri, Doda, Anantnag, & Baramulla. As per the MCI guidelines 200 kanals of land for each colleges is required. The land in respect of the Medical College Anantnag is in the process of acquisition. After establishment of the Medical College, the health care facilities will improve significantly at Anantnag as Medical College is a tertiary care hospital and faculty members of Medical College are super specialists in their respective fields.

The procedure for identification of the land for establishment of AIIMS in the Kashmir Division will be initiated after formal communication is received from the central government.

In view of the above I request the Hon'ble Member to withdraw the resolution.
