The Council met in the Council Hall Srinagar at 11.00 Hrs.

(Hon'ble Chairman, Haji Anayat Ali, in the Chair)

As soon as the House assembled for today's business, **Mr. G. N. Monga & Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar Hon'ble Members** from opposition raised the issue regarding use of unparliamentarily language by the Hon'ble Members yesterday and requested the Chair that those Hon'ble Members who used unparliamentarily language must apologize. On this Hon'ble Chairman condemn at the same and directed that the unparliamentarily words used be expunged and further stated that Hon'ble Members should maintain dignity of this August House and also directed opposition Members to take their respective seats.

FURTHER DISCUSSION ON RESOLUTION

As soon as Hon'ble Chair asked Mr. Ashok Khajuria to speak on Resolution, Mr. G. N. Monga joined by other opposition Members protested for not giving the first opportunity to speak on the Resolution be a precedence of the House and tried to pacify the agitated Members to participate. On this the Chair informed that the speakers names have not been received so far and tried to pacify the agitated Members who were not satisfied and staged **Walk-out**. Hon'ble Chair tried to pacify the agitated Members, not satisfied the Members from Opposition latter staged a **walk-out**.

Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member demanded up-gradation of internet facilities to some hilly areas like Badarwah, Kistiwar and Guraz as technologically these are lagging far behind.

In response **Dr. Haseeb A. Drabu, Hon'ble Minister for Finance, Labour & Employment** said that this can be done offline also even after 4-months and further stated that he has got assurance from **Government Of India** that this demand will be looked into.

Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member demanded that the persons who are being benefitted by centre-sponsored schemes should not be impacted and also demanded that Walnut growers should be exempted.

On this Dr. Haseeb A. Drabu, Hon'ble Minister for Finance, Labour & Employment stated that Handicrafts are being exempted and the demand to exempt Walnut will be looked into.

5:38 Hrs **Hon'ble Chairman, Haji Anayat Ali** moved that "This house resolves that the Government of Jammu and Kashmir may give consent to the adoption of GST regime by application or relevant amendments made to the constitution of India in a modified manner to safeguard the existing special constitutional position of J&K in the Union Of India and the Legislative powers under the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir".

Resolution was put before the House, and was passed by **Voice- Vote**.

The Council was adjourned to meet again on Friday on **7th of July -2017 at 03:00 pm.**
