BILL FOR CONSIDERATION AND RETURN

Mr. Haseeb A Drabu, Hon'ble Minister for Finance, Labour and Employment moved that:-

“ A Bill to make a provision for levy and collection of tax on intra-state supply of goods or services or both by the State of Jammu and Kashmir and the matters connected therewith or incidental thereto (L.A. Bill NO. 6 of 2017) as passed by the Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly, be taken into consideration.”

Mr. Imran Raza Ansari, Hon'ble Minister for Information Technology seconded the Bill.

Hon'ble Chairman put the Bill for consideration which was adopted by Voice Vote.

Mr. Haseeb A Drabu, Hon'ble Minister for Finance, Labour and Employment moved that Bill be returned.

The Bill was put to Vote & was passed by Voice Vote

BILL FOR CONSIDERATION AND PASSING

On behalf of Dr. Nirmal Kumar Singh, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister for Housing and Urban Development, Mtr. Asiya Naqash, Hon'ble Minister of State for Health & Medical Education moved that:-

“ A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Civic Laws (Special Provisions) Act, 2014 (L.A. Bill NO. 5 of 2017) as passed by the Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly, be taken into consideration”.

Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue seconded the Bill.

Hon'ble Chairman put the Bill for consideration which was adopted by Voice Vote.

Mtr. Asiya Naqash, Hon'ble Minister of State for Health & Medical Education moved that Bill be returned.

The Bill was put to Vote & was passed by Voice Vote.

Mr. Haseeb A Drabu, Hon'ble Minister for Finance, Labour and Employment: - said the Government has proven its commitment to safe guard States Constitutional position and its Legislative Powers while implementing the GST and the protection granted to the J&K's Special Status in the Presidential Order on GST was the outcome of an exercise conducted by the Government. Notwithstanding and continued in Clause-IV to Clause-XI for the purpose of any decision in plugging on the

Constitutional Provisions relating to the state of Jammu and Kashmir, the concurrence of the representative of the State of J&K in the Goods and Service Tax council shall be mandatory and the procedure provided under Article-370 shall be followed.

Mrs. Mehbooba Mufti, Hon'ble Chief Minister stated that implementation of Goods and Service Tax in Jammu and Kashmir, along with "safeguards" to protect the State's Special Position was the "first big challenge" for the government that talks of maintaining a status-quo on Article-370 of the Constitution of India. She further stated that President Pranab Mukherjee's and Prime Minister Narendra Modi's approval "without changing a single word" to the draft presidential order prepared by the State Government to ensure protection of State's Special Position has send a message in the state that the coalition government has "fulfilled the commitment" they respected the sentiment and emotions of people and approved our document that in the first time that the J&K Assembly discussed a Resolution to adopt something from the Union Government Of India. She further stated that late Hon'ble Chief Minister Jenab. Mufti Mohammad Saeed would often reiterate that J&K Kashmir Assembly isthe "most empowered Assembly in India".

She further said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has the "Courage and power" to take J&K State out of sufferings.

At the end she thanked the Hon'ble Finance Minister, Dr. Haseeb A Drabu and his team and Mr. Muzaffar Hussain Baigh, Hon'ble Parliament Member.
