**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs**

As soon as the House assembled for today's Business, Members from BJP and some Congress Members raised an issue regarding militant attack on CRPF at Pampore and demanded statement from government. They also demanded that House should condemn it unanimously.

**On this Syed Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Leader of the House** stated that it is a matter of concern and **Hon'ble Chief Minister** condemned the incident and paid rich tributes to the martyrs. State Government is reviewing the entire security scenario of the State. Regarding compensation normal norms will be followed.
