The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs

Question Hour

Starred C.Q.Nos. 91, 534, 601, Clubbed C.Q.Nos. (199, 352, 413, 494), 280, 684 & 123 were orally answered.

In response to C. Q. NO. 91 asked by Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member regarding Para Medical Training. On behalf of Minister for Health, Syed Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Hon'ble Minister (Leader of the House) replied on behalf of the government and the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members were replied by Choudhary Lal Singh, Hon'ble Minister.

In response to C. Q. NO. 534 asked by Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member regarding Repair of Pipelines. Syed. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi, MOS for PHE replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members. The supplementary asked by Mr. Yasir Reshi regarding misuse of pipes by department Hon'ble Minister informed the House that he will look into it and if something fishy is found action will be taken.

In response to C. Q. NO. 601 asked by Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member regarding Flood Measures. Syed. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi, MOS for Irrigation and Flood Control replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members, not satisfied with the reply, the Chair directed to the Hon'ble Minister to provide full details to the Hon'ble Member.

In response to Clubbed C. Q. Nos. (199, 352, 413 & 494) asked by Shri. Ramesh Arora, Mr. Mohammad Khurshid Alam, Shri. Ashok Khuajuria, Mr. Yasir Reshi, Hon'ble Members regarding NFSA. Choudhary Zulfikar Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CA&PD replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members. While replying the Supplementary asked by Mr. Yasir Reshi, Hon'ble Member regarding left out families of Sumbal Area, Shri. Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding supply of ration to Employees/ Retired Kashmiri Migrants. Hon'ble Minister stated that ration will be provided to non relief migrants if requisition to this effect is received from Relief Commission. Hon'ble Minister informed the House that it is a continuous process for updating the data and asked the Member to submit the details and action will be taken accordingly.

In response to C. Q. NO. 280 asked by Shri. Surinder Kumar Choudhary, Hon'ble Members regarding creation of Religious Corridors in different areas to attract pilgrim tourists, Ms. Priya Sethi, MOS for Tourism replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members. While intervening Syed Naeem Akhter, Leader of the House stated that establishing Corridors at religious places depends upon the potential to investment and said that government is also keen to give boost to pilgrim Tourism.

In response to C. Q. NO. 684 asked by Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Member regarding Allotment of Pampore Flats. On behalf of Minister for Estates, Hon'ble Minister for Education replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Member and stated that if any error is found government is committed to rectify that.

In response to C. Q. NO. 123 asked by Shri. Jugal Kishore Sharma, Hon'ble Member regarding Battery Cars. **Shri. Sunil Kumar Sharma, MOS for Transport** replied the supplementaries raised by the **Hon'ble Member**.

The replies of **Starred C.Q.Nos. 180, 229, 701, 619 & 84** and **Unstarred C.Q.Nos. 657, 535, 336, 483, 453, 165, 77, 146, 374, 355, 579, 416, 398, 50, 97, 267 & 116** were laid on the table of the House.

PAPERS LAID

On behalf Dr. Haseeb A. Drabu, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue, Syed Basharat Ahmad Bukhari laid on the table of the House a copy of the Annual Audit Report of the J&K State Financial Corporation (J&KSFC) for the years 2013-14 and 2014-15, as provided under section 37(7) of J&K State Financial Corporation's Act.

Point Of Information

Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member Raised an issue regarding the news item published in today's news paper namely Rising Kashmir in which it is mentioned that Mosque Imams will be under surveillance. On this **Syed Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Leader of the House** stated that every news paper is best source for information but said that it is not necessary whatever they publish is correct, and said as per his knowledge there is no base for this particular news published in today's issue.

Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member informed blocking of Sai Nallah from Pahalgam side which is connecting Wadwan in Kishtwar and due to blocking of this Nallah, people have to cover the journey for three days and also stated that locals are creating hurdles to non Kashmiris and are not allowing them to work and requested the governments for intervention. **On this Syed Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister** stated that concerned agencies have been directed to look into it.

Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding Khascharai and stated that some people from Humhama & Gogu village has approached him regarding transfer of Khaschari land under Roshni Act but have been denied the same. Although some influential people have encroached on the Khascharai land and are in position of the same illegally. All Members supported him. **Mr. Yasir Reshi, Hon'ble Member** demanded that a House Committee be constituted to enquire the whole episode. He was supported by majority of the Members. **On this Syed Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue** stated that he will abide by the directions of the Chair, and if Chair directs he has no objection on the constitution of House Committee. On this the Chair directed that high level enquiry committee be constituted in the matter, and after the report of the committee is received the decision regarding constitution of House Committee will be taken if required. **Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri & Shri. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Members** raised an issue regarding uploading of a video on the website showing the pictures of children with weapons in their hands and requested that government should take cognizance of it. On this **Syed Naeem Akhter, Leader of the House** stated that it is a matter of concern & government will look into it.

CALLING ATTENTION

I) Mr. Ghulam Nabi Monga, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards the grievance of the contractual employees of the Khadi Village Industries Board working from the last 22 years as the results of their interviews conducted in 2008 have not yet been declared despite the approval of the Board and the steps taken by the Government to address their grievance and also to constitute the Board.

Shri. Chander Prakash Ganga, Minister for Industries replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

II) Mr. Zafar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards slow pace of work on Zorah-Manloo canal due to which a draught like situation has developed in the area irrigated by it, especially, villages Shadab and Khrew, owing to rise in temperature and hundreds of kanals of agricultural land and orchids are vulnerable to destruction and the steps taken by the Government to expedite the work and to save the lands from destruction.

Syed Farooq Ahmad Andrabi, MOS for PHE replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and sated that he will take it personally and work on it will be speeded up.

III) Mr. Mohammad Khursheed Alam, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards Slaughtering of sheep in almost every Mohalla of Srinagar City, in absence of proper slaughter houses, thereby creating a havoc, especially in residential areas due to choking of drains and also giving rise to dog menace and the steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

Ms. Asea Naqash, MOS Housing & Urban Development replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

IV) Mr. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards converting of Wazir Point Manda wild life sanctuary into a park and removal of climber and deforestation being carried out by the people residing inside the sanctuary and the steps taken by the Government to check this practice and to improve the wild life sanctuary.

Choudhary Lal singh, Minister for Forests replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member

(BILL FOR CONSIDERATION AND RETURN)

I) On behalf of Dr. Haseeb A. Drabu, Shri. Ajay Nanda, Hon'ble MOS for Finance moved that: -

“A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000 (L.A Bill No. 2 of 2016) as passed by the Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly, be taken into consideration”.

Syed Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Leader of the House seconded the motion of the Bill.

Hon'ble Vice chairman put the Bill for consideration which was adopted by Voice Vote.

Shri. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member moved amendments to Bill

the amendments were opposed by the Hon'ble Minister for Education.
