**(Brief Record Of Proceedings)**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs**

**(Hon'ble Chairman Haji. Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

As House assembled for today's business **Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member** informed the House regarding the sad demise of **Mr. Ghulam Geelani Ex. Legislator. Hon'ble Chairman** made obituary reference on the said demise of **Mr. Ghulam Geelani** and 2 minutes silence was observed by the House.

**Hon'ble Chairman** stated that it is very unfortunate that yesterday due to lack of quorum the discussion Under Rule (51) which was raised by **Mr. Mohammad Muzaffar Parry** could not be held and further stated that decorum should be maintained in future, and Members should remain present in the House during the **Business Hour**.

**Point of Information**

**Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding Khacharai land at Soiteng Lasjan which was donated to Panchayat for construction of Panchayat building but some people are forcefully trying to grab the said land and requested to look into the matter, and handed over the paper to the Chair, in this regard. The **Hon'ble Chairman** directed the Secretary to deliver the said papers to **Hon'ble Minister for Revenue** for necessary action.

**Shri. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding Auditor and Computer General of India report that 43 substandard medicines are being supplied in hospitals and demanded that House Committee be constituted in this regard. The **Chair** directed the Member to submit the documents and stated that ruling in this regard will be given by tomorrow.

**Mr. Yasir Reshi, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding enchoachment of Khascharai land at Humhama Colony by some influential persons and stated that FIR was lodged in this regard, but since the influential people are involved in it the same has been closed.

**While intervening Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri** stated that **Ramesh Arora's** issue is serious and demanded that House Committee be framed to look into the matter.

**Question Hour**

**Starred C.Q.Nos. 387, 362, 261, 572 & Clubbed C.Q.Nos. (49, 234, 337 & 476) were orally answered.**

**In response to C. Q. NO. 387** asked by **Shri. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member** regarding execution of Micro Mini Hydel Project under public private partnership. **MOS for PDD, Mr. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi** replied the supplementaries raised by the **Hon'ble Members**, and informed the House that the process will be completed and directed the officials/ officers of PDD for providing the details to the **Hon'ble Member**.

**In response to C. Q. NO. 362** asked by **Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri, Hon'ble Member** regarding VDCS. **On behalf of Minister for Home, Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister** assured the House that as & when situation improves, review meetings regarding VDC's is being held and the same is being held after the interval of every six months. He further stated that if there will be some complaint against any VDC that will be investigated. **Not satisfied with the reply Hon'ble Member staged a walk out.**

**In response to C. Q. NO. 261 asked by Dr. Shehnaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** regarding Power Consumption. Hon'ble MOS for PDD, **Mr. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi** replied the supplementaries raised by the **Hon'ble Members**. While intervening the Chair directed the **Hon'ble Minister** for regularization of temporary employees as they are working for the last 22 years. The Hon'ble Minister informed the House that he will look into it. While replying to the supplementary asked by Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas regarding filling of 150 posts of JEE, the Hon'ble Minister stated that the process is on for filling up the posts of JEE'S and will be filled in time bound manner. Regarding creation of Board of Directors, **Hon'ble Minister** informed the House that Board of Directors will be constituted very soon. While intervening **Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister** Board of Directors will be constituted very soon .

**In response to C. Q. NO. 572 asked by Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member regarding Indus Water Treaty, Hon'ble MOS for PHE Minister** replied the supplementaries raised by the **Hon'ble Member**. While replying supplementary asked by **Hon'ble Member** regarding loss suffered due to Indus Water Treaty , on this Hon'ble Minister sated that government has appointed an auditor to access the loses. While intervening Mr. Abdul Reham Veeri, Hon'ble Minister stated that the issue has been taken up with the Government of India for compensation against losses.

**In response to Clubbed C. Q. NO's (49, 234, 337 & 476) asked by Ms. Rani Gargi Blowria, Shri. Sham Lal Bhagat, Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganai, S. Charanjeet Singh, Hon'ble Members** regarding engagement of SPO's. Hon'ble MOS for PDD **Minister** replied the supplementaries raised by the **Hon'ble Members**.
