**(Brief Record Of Proceedings)**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs**

**(Hon'ble Chairman Haji. Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

**11: 00 Hrs**

As soon as the House assembled for today's Business, **Hon'ble Chairman stated that he has received a report from Mr. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member** regarding supply of spurious drugs in Government Hospitals as per report of the CAG, and further stated that a House Committee will be constituted to look into the matter.

All Hon'ble Members from opposition were on their feet and demanding statement from government regarding action taken against the IAS officer whose name cropped up in the case regarding suicide attempt by another IAS officer. Hon'ble Chair tried to pacify the agitated Members but they continued their protest.

**Point of Information**

**Shri. Ajatshatru Singh, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding constitution of joint House Committee on Mubarakh Mandi Heritage.

**Dr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding illegal constructions at Pahalgam.

**The Members from opposition** continued their protest and came in to the well, there were ruckus in the House. **Chair directed Hon'ble Member Shri. Jugal Kishore Sharma, Hon'ble Member to raise his question.**

**Question Hour**

**Starred C.Q.Nos. 114, 523, Clubbed C.Q.No's (406, 553 & 702), Clubbed C.Q.No's (137 & 570), 621 & Clubbed C.Q.No's (358 & 640) were orally answered.**

**In response to C. Q. NO. 114 asked by Shri. Jugal Kishore Sharma, Hon'ble Member** regarding drying up of Drinking Water Resources affeted due to the construction of railway track from Katra to Bakhal. **Shri. Sham Lal Choudhary, Hon'ble Minister for PHE** replied the supplementary raised by the **Hon'ble Member.**

**Chair tried to pacify the agitated Members and** directed them to take their respective seats but they continued their protest and resorted to sloganeering against government. Members from treasury benches also stood up and exchanged heated words with each other. Noisy scene were

witnessed in the House. **Syed. Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Leader of the House** intervened and requested the Members to take their seats but there was ruckus in the House and Hon'ble Chairman adjourned the House for 5 minutes.

**House Re-assembled**

**Chair directed Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member to raise his question.**

**In response to C. Q. NO. 523 asked by Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member** regarding Deen Dayal Scheme. **On behalf of Minister for PDD, Syed. Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Hon'ble Minister** replied the supplementary raised by the **Hon'ble Member**. While replying to Hon'ble Member regarding 2-time tendering, the Hon'ble Minister stated that this is a 3-time tendering and it needs to be taken up with GOI.

**Hon'ble Members** from opposition demanded FIR to be lodged against the IAS officer and wanted to know why Government is shielding the IAS Officer, **on this Syed. Naeem Akhter, Leader of the House** asked the agitated Members to disclose the name of the Officer. **Members from NC & Mr. G. N. Monga** except Dr. Shehnaz Ganai & Master Noor Hussaian & **staged a walk out.**

**In response to Clubbed C. Q. NO's. (406, 553 & 702) asked by Sofi Mohammad Yousuf, Mohammad Khursheed Alam & Mohammad Muzaffar Parry, Hon'ble Members** regarding Car Parking In Place General Bus-Stand Jammu. **MOS for Housing, Ms. Asea Naqash** replied the supplementaries raised by the **Hon'ble Members**. While responding to the Supplementary asked by the **Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** stated that is there any time bound plane to construct Multi Parking slot at Jammu, **Dr. Shehnaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** stated that there is no parking facility from Amphala to Bantalab & Jewel to Talab Tiloo on this Hon'ble Minister stated that parking facility will be provided in near future.

**In response to Clubbed C. Q. NO's. (137 & 570) asked by Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta & Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Members** regarding Urdu Language, **On behalf of Minister For Culture, Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister**, replied the supplementaries raised by the **Hon'ble Members**. **Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas** stated that Urdu Language should be made compulsory up to 10<sup>th</sup> class and also demanded that report of Khanday Committee be implemented. **Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta** stated that modernization of land settlement due to non-availability of Urdu knowing and demanded the retired persons be engaged for the job. Dr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri stated that there is shortage of Urdu teachers as per the Khanday committee report. Sofi Yousuf stated that training be given to newly appointed Naib Tesildars who don't know Urdu. **While intervening Syed Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister** stated that a Resolution on Urdu Language was adopted by the House earlier. The report of Khanday Committee is with government & government is examining the same. The work of land settlement has started and he is not satisfied with the job as the same is not satisfied & is monitoring himself. After every 15 days a review meeting is being held to keep eye in the process. Government is also property to engage Urdu knowing persons. He further stated that non-Urdu knowing new appointed Naib Tehsildar's will be imparted Urdu training & he has also cleared the file of those aspirants whose cases have been decided by Hon'ble High Court. While intervening **Syed. Naeem Akhter Andrabi, Leader of the House** promised that efforts will be made to promote this Language.

**In response to C. Q. NO. 621 asked by Shri. Ajatshatru Singh, Hon'ble Member** regarding Jagata Athem Road. **On behalf of Minister for R&B, Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister** replied the supplementary raised by the **Hon'ble Member**.

**In response to Clubbed C. Q. NO's. (358 & 640) asked by Dr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri & Mr. Mohammad Muzaffar Parry, Hon'ble Members regarding Warrant of Precedence, On behalf of Minister for Hospitality & Protocol, Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister** replied the supplementary raised by the **Hon'ble Member**. While replying to the supplementary asked by the **Hon'ble Member** regarding proving list of Officers against whom action taken and punishment given, **Hon'ble Minister** stated that list will be provided to the Hon'ble Member. And stated that Legislator is himself an institution and it is a duty of an officer to respect the Legislator and assured that if there is any violation it will be looked into.

**CALLING ATTENTION**

**I) Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government, towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to vacant office of the State Chief Information Commissioner, with the result hundreds of cases are lying un-attended, thereby causing great inconveniences to the public at large and the steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

**Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture Production** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member also stated that government is in the processes & it will be done very soon.

**II) Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to bad condition of Pratabpora-Ziapora to Baripora road in District Shopian and steps taken by the Government in this regard.

**Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture Production** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member & stated that the matter will be taken with the concern.

**Shri. Jugal Kishore Shrama, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding providing of information regarding CDF. On this **Vice Chairman** directed the information will be provided by Saturday.

**III) Mr. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to non-availability of Sanskrit teachers in Rajouri District in particular and Jammu Division in general, due to which number of students of the language has diminished to almost nil and the language is near extinction and the steps underway to save this valuable language.

**Syed Naeem Akhter, Leader of the House** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

**Mr. Showkat Hussain Gnai and Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta** requested that wages of National Pension Scheme teachers and RET be released. On this the **Hon'ble Minister** stated that since the state was on Vote on account now the Budget has been passed and wages will be released very soon.

**IV) Mr. Surinder Choudhary, Hon'ble Member** to call the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to delay in construction of road from Kahian to Handan via Sewbha in Tehsil Nowshera, District Rajouri despite availability of funds and the steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

**Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture Production** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and also stated that enquiry will be conducted in this regard and further stated that officers will be booked if found guilty.

**V) Mr. Saif-ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member** to call the attention of the government towards the problems being faced by people in Halqas Lassipora, Parthan in Khansahib constituency which have recently been included in Block Sokhnag and lack basic transport facilities being far away from Block Sokhnag and the steps taken by the Government in this regard.
