Sham Lal Bhagat** regarding number of schools upgraded in the Doda District for the last two years, **Syed Naeem Akhter, Hon'ble Minister for Education** assured the House that remaining schools falling within norms will be taken up under RAMSA, as the matter is being seriously followed with Government of India for providing of funds under RAMSA, which have been stopped by Union Government and the Secretary Education is seriously perusing the matter with Government of India.
