**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs  
(Hon'ble Chairman Haji. Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

**11:00 Hrs**

As soon as the House assembled for today's Business **Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding shortage of sugar for J&K State, Keeping in view the festivals starting from the current month.

**Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding nuisance created by some miscreants with tourists at Pahalgam while complaining against these miscreants the S.H.O concerned insulted the **Hon'ble Member** & also made bad remarks against **this August House**.

In response to this **Syed Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue** directed the Home Secretary to provide necessary information in this regard.

The opposition Members from NC, wanted to know from the Government regarding establishment of **Sanik Coloney at Kashmir**.

In Response to this **Dr. Nirmal Singh, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister** said that there is no such proposal at present before the Government. However if Army constructs any Residential Quarters inside Badami Bagh Cantonment area within their domain, Government has no concern with the same. There are rumors only to just to polarize the society.

**Starred C.Q.Nos. 399, 459, 365, 558, 479, 408, 44, 71, 437 & 689 were orally answered.**

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 399** asked by **Mr. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member** regarding Village-Wise schemes being carried out for safe drinking water in Rajouri District, while intervening **Syed. Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue** stated that regarding grabbing of Land, he will talk to Deputy Commissioner Rajouri & he will be asked to take action accordingly.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No.459** asked by **S. Dharambir Singh Oberoi, Hon'ble Member** regarding present status and completion of four laning of the Jammu-Srinagar National Highly.

**Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** assured the House that work on the Four Laning is going on smoothly and said the execution of work is being carried on fast track basis on the Highway. Although all bottlenecks have been removed, however still if there is any bottleneck same will be removed on priority basis.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 365** asked by **Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri, Hon'ble Member** regarding up-gradation of roads in Bijbehara Constituency, On behalf of **Hon'ble Minister for R&B, Minister for RDD, Mr. Abdul. Haq Khan** assured the House that 25-KM road Macadamization will be taken up.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 558** asked by **Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member** regarding 5% reservation to Pahari speaking people, **Shri. Sajad Gani Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Social Welfare** stated that the Bill regarding reservation to Pahari speaking people has been received back from Hon'ble Governor with some observations as soon as these are clarified the

same will be kept before the cabinet for approval and will not waste any moment to make the commission functional.

Charanjit Singh, Hon'ble Member** regarding details of sports schemes being implemented and total budget allocation made by the Government in the previous year to develop the sports, while intervening **Mr. Ahmad Javid Mirchal, Hon'ble Member** requested that a physical teacher be provided to Government school Tangdar, on this **Hon'ble Minister** assured that teacher will be provided.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 44** asked by **Smt. Rani Gargi Blowria, Hon'ble Member** regarding hiring of private cranes for lifting of vehicles in Jammu and Srinagar cities, **Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** assured the House that Government will look into it and the wrong if any done in past will not repeated, there will be complete transparency in the matter in future.
