The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs

(Hon'ble Chairman Haji. Anayat Ali in the Chair)

As soon as the **House assembled for today's business** all the Opposition Members stood up and raised the issue regarding Russian poplar trees which are causing health hazard and in this regard the Members from Opposition referred the news item published in today's news paper and implementation of Hon'ble High Court directions and were demanding that Government should come with a statement in this regard.

Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member, raised a point that fire has spread out at Chirala Forests compartment , Badarwah for last 4-days and said that there is a nexus between timber smugglers & forest Officers/ Officials.

Hon'ble Minister for Forests, Choudhary Lal Singh informed the House that Government have almost cutted down all poplar trees on Government land but are getting stiff resistance from private person having planted there trees on their private land, but still they are complying the Court directions.

While replying the issue raised by **Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta** regarding Fire of Badarwah forests, the **Hon'ble Minister for Forests, Choudhary Lal Singh** stated that fire is under control as teams of Forest Protection Force have been dispatched to monitor the situation.

Dr. Shehnaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member raised the issue regarding news item published in today's news paper about a statement made by Sadhvi Prachi, regarding the Muslim free India and all Hon'ble Members from opposition stood up from their seats and demanded that Government should come up with a statement in this regard.

Syed Naeem Akhter, Hon'ble Minister for Education condemn it and said that Muslims are important part of this largest populated democratic country and Muslims are the part and parcel of this Country.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 127** asked by **Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** regarding Health Institutions, while replying Mr. Bali Baghat, Hon'ble Minister for Health assured that Doctors will be provided within month and un-authorized diagnostic centers will be closed by the enforcing agency.

CALLING ATTENTION

I) Mr. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to dilapidated condition of old Girls Higher Secondary School, Rajouri, which could collapse anytime and the steps taken by the Government to avoid any kind of untoward happening.

Hon'ble Minister for Education, Syed. Naeem Akhter replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and assured the that DPR has been prepared and new building will be provided in near future.

II) Mr. Jugal Kishore Sharma, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the non-installation of transformer and poles at villages Kosal and Loudra in Pytt Sadhota, Tehsil Panchari, District Udhampur, in spite of the fact that poles and transformers were provided about five months back, with the result, people of these two villages are suffering and the steps to taken by the Government in this regard.

Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, Dr. Nirmal Singh replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

1. One village electrified (Kosal).
2. Regarding the other village Loudra, the **Chair** directed the **Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister** to send at least J.E level officer to the village for on spot assessment of the situation.

III) Mr. Surinder Choudhary, Hon'ble Member called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due rise in the activities of drug mafia in J&K State and steps taken by the Government to curb this menace.

Hon'ble Minister for RDD, Mr. Abdul Haq Khan replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and assured the House that nobody will be spared involved in drug mafia, The Hon'ble Minister being Law Minister also assured the House that he will make all efforts to make the Officer/ Prosecution being responsible for preparation case diary free of technical faults to improve the conviction rate in the NDPS Act case.

Shri. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi, Hon'ble Minister of State for Hajj & Auqaf stated that yesterday **Dr. Shehnaz Ganai** raised a point regarding the persons who are going to perform Umrah, but air India cancelled its morning flights the matter was taken with Civil Aviation and they agreed to accommodate 15 passengers on its 3:30 pm flight and remaining 17 persons will be accommodated tomorrow on same flight enabling them to take their onward flights to Jeddah.
