**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs**

As soon as the **House assembled for today's business** all the Opposition Members stood up and raised the issue regarding resolution moved by them against Sadhvi Prachi and demanded that the same may be admitted and listed for debate, The Hon'ble Chairman informed the House that resolution is with the Chair and stated that Leader of the House made a statement yesterday in the House, and tried to pacify the agitating Members but Members from Opposition continued their protests, raised slogans against Sadhvi Prachi, BJP & VHP.

**Members** from treasury bench also stood up and raised slogans against Militant outfits.

**Hon'ble Minister for RDD, Mr. Abdul Haq Khan** stated that yesterday Leader of the House condemned the same in the House and now there is no scope to raise the issue again.

**Mr. Ajatshatru Singh, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding news item published in today's Edition of Early Times. news paper about a statement regarding attack on K.P Colonies and demanded a statement from Government in this behalf.

**Starred C.Q. Nos. 598, 307, 204, 236, 515, 106, 339 & 498 were orally answered.**

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 361** asked by **Mr. Ghulam Nabi Monga, Hon'ble Member** regarding new Industrial Policy, While intervening **Hon'ble Chief Minister, Ms. Mehbooba Mufti** stated that recently we held a meeting with **Hon'ble Prime Minister** at New Delhi regarding Skill Development and stated that we have concentrate on Skill Development as it a Heritage of our State and will provide incentives to flourish this industry. As we have very high Heritage Wood Carving, Paper Machie in Kashmir and in Jammu Basoli Arts, Basoli Paintings etc. Education Ministry has been directed to introduce Skill Development courses at school level. There is no Question of dilution of Article 370. The participation of locals in industrial units is very low & big Corporate House should be involved adopting to give skill training to locals.

**Dr. Nirmal Singh, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister**, also stated that industrial policy is for the welfare of the State and as per as ratio is concerned only state subjects will fall in this.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 515** asked by **Mr. Saif-Ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member** regarding Electricity Receiving Station, **Mr. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi, Hon'ble Minister of State for PDD** assured the House that work will be completed during current financial year.

**CALLING ATTENTION**

**I) Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to delay in re-alignment/construction/improvement of Galhar-Sansari Road (from 55 km to 58kms) via Ishtehari which is pending from more than two years and steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

**Hon'ble Minister for RDD, Mr. Abdul Haq Khan** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

**II) Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to non-

implementation of Total Literacy Program/Saakshar Bharat Mission (scheme) in District Shopian and steps taken by the Government in this regard.

**Hon'ble Minister for Education, Syed Naeem Akhter** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

**III) Mr. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards the dilapidated condition of the much claimed Tulip Garden in Bhour Camp area in Jammu spread over 583 kanals of land, which is being damaged due to flood water and encroachment. Also, Maharaja Hari Singh Park, inaugurated by former Chief Minister, Shri Ghulam Nabi Azad, is in a pitiable condition and steps taken by the government to restore the glory of the garden/park and to stop land wastage and encroachment.

**Hon'ble Minister of State for Floriculture, Ms. Priya Sethi** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

**The Hon'ble Member** further stated that in Manda Sanctuary three ponds have dried up due water shortage and three animals have died.
