As soon as the House assembled for today's business **Mr. Ramesh Arora** along with his party members stood up and protested regarding omitting his Resolution which was already listed in today's business. He was supported by **Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member.**

On this **Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** stated that it is the final decision of Chair. Since it a foreign affairs issue and can't be discussed here.

Starred C.Q. Nos. 227, 344, 251, 614, 177 & 88 were orally answered.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 277** asked by **Mr. Surinder Kumar Choudhary, Hon'ble Member** regarding construction of roads/ bridges in Nowshera and Sunderbani areas, **on behalf of Minister for R&B, Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** assured the House that government will try to accommodate roads under central sponsored schemes.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 251** asked by **Dr. Shehnaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** regarding LOC Trade, while intervening **Ms. Mehbooba Mufti, Hon'ble Chief Minister** stated that Government is committed to request the Center Government to open more routes with POK for divided families & trade at Kargil – Askerdu silk route, Jammu-Sialkot, Turdukh-Khaplu, Chambjurian-Mirpur, Gurez-Astur Gilgit, Teetwal-Chilan and Gangarh-Nowshera routs for border tourism will be opened in phased manner and Volvo Buses be introduced for travel purpose. She further stated that to facilitate good trade at border, there is a proposal with RBI to facilitate Banking service in dollars at trade points. She stated that in her last meeting with Union Home Minister and requested him to legalize the Nepal route for those youths who wants to return back from Pakistan to live peaceful life and there is also a proposal to introduce ceremonial parade at Suchetgarh Border at the pattern of Wagah Border, Government is committed to create peaceful atmosphere in the State.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 177** asked by **Mr. Ajatshatru Singh, Hon'ble Member** regarding development of Maharaja Hari Singh Park on the banks of River Tawi, **Minister of MOS for PHE, Mr. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi** assured the House that work is going on and will be completed within this financial year.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 614** asked by **Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member** regarding clubbed/ closed down some schools in the State, **on behalf of Minister for Education, Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** stated that the concern of the Member is genuine and there would be no compromise, education will be given top priority so that no dropout took place.
