Before the commencement of the Question Hour **Shri Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member** raised a point of order regarding yesterday's incident which occurred at Aap Shambu temple at Roop nagar Jammu. He was joined by his party members and some members from Opposition also. **Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta** stated that Police entered into the Houses at Janipura locality and ransacked the Houses. The Members were demanding that government should come up with a statement in this regard. On this **Sayed Naeem Akhter**, Minister for Education (Leader of the House) made a statement.

1. **Shri Zaffer Iqbal Manhas**, raised a point to amalgamate Wakaf board and Wakaf Council and to make it vibrant and transparent.

**Hon'ble Deputy Chairman Jahangir Hussian Mir in the Chair**

2. **Shri Vibod Gupta**, requested for opening of new Anganwadi Centres constituency wise and Anganwadi workers may be brought under pension scheme.
3. **Shri Ghulam Nabi Monga**, regarding shortage of drinking water in down town areas.
4. **Sofi Yousuf**, raised a point regarding illegal construction of Hotels at Yanner Pahalagam.
5. **Shri Vikramditya Singh**, raised a issue regarding yesterdays desecration act at Aap Shambu Temple Roop nagar Jammu and requested that action be taken against culprits.
6. **Shri Saif-ud-Din Bhat**, raised an issue regarding non cleaning of tanks at Khan Sabhib Constituency, which blocks drinking water of 40 villages.
7. **Master Noor Hussain**, raised an issue regarding shortage of drinking water at Gujjar Basities of Samba.
8. **Shri Naresh Kumar Gupta**, requested that Daily Wagers engaged by different Development Authorities for maintaining parks be regularized.
9. **Dr. Shehnaz Ganai**, requested for shifting of revenue record room from Heritage Poonch Fort to safer place.
10. **Mr. Ramesh Arora**, requested for constitution of Minority Commission.
11. **Mr. Yasir Reshi**, raised a point that while framing a agriculture policy, Horticulture should be given a space.
12. **Mr. Mohammad Khursheed Alam**, regarding slow process of conducting exams and Interviews by recruiting agencies.
13. **Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak**, regarding clashing of NET & PSC exams on 19<sup>th</sup> of this month & shortage of drinking water in Kishtiwari.
14. **Mr. Sham Lal Baghat**, raised an issue that on the floor of this House, **Hon'ble Health Minister** assured that an MBBS Doctor will be provide cat Assar within a day but unfortunately instead of providing doctor, concerned BMO has been transferred. On this the Chair directed that matter be taken with Health Minister and doctor be provided.
15. **Mr. Surinder Kumar Choudhary**, raised an issue regarding streamlining of fee structure in Private schools.
16. **Mr. Sajjad Ahmad Kichloo**, raised an issue regarding shortage of Drinking water in Gundoh and Kishtiwari & unscheduled power cuts in different parts of Kishtiwari areas.
17. **Mr. Ajatshutru Singh**, raised the issue of poor performance of Government Schools and also requested that there should be criteria for establishment of private schools.
18. **S. Charanjeet Singh**, requested that incentives be given to the local industrialists.
19. **Mr. Ashok Khajuria**, requested that Punjabi language be explored.
20. **Mr. Jugal Kishore Sharma**, raised an issue regarding that no concession is being given to BPL & local residents of Katra by super specialty Hospital established by Vaishnu Devi Shrine Board.

CALLING ATTENTION

I) **Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to delay in installation of a ropeway in Padder sub-division and the steps taken by the Government to expedite the same.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

II) **Mr. Jugal Kishore, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the Government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the non-electrification of village Padder and surrounding areas which was funded through CDF amounting to Rs. 30 lakhs in year 2012, and steps taken by the Government to save the State ex-chequer from this huge loss.

**Mr. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi, MOS Power** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member. Not satisfied with reply, **Mr. Jugal Kishore Sharma, Hon'ble Member** stated that the matter be investigated as he has provided 30 lakh's out of his CDF for electrification of some villages of Padder area, while intervening, **Mr Abdul Haq Khan, Minister for RDD** stated that concerned DC will be directed to conduct enquiry. On this the Chair directed that enquiry should be time bound and DC be directed to submit the report within 15 days, which will be shared with the House.

Point Of Information

**Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri, Hon'ble Member** stated that has Government taken any cognizance why people were protesting at Poonch Mandi road and demanding lodging of FIR.

III) **Mr. Javed Ahmad Mirchal, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to delay in construction of bridge on Nallah Hardan, Nawa Gabra, the work of which was taken up in 2008, till date, even a pillar has not been erected and the steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.
