The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs

### 11:00 Hrs

As soon as the House assembled for today's business **Shri. Ramesh Arora & other Hon'ble Members** raised the issue that no body from Government has taken care of victim injured due to militant attack at Kud who is wife of an employee of this Secretariat. Only 20 thousand were paid to him from Red Cross Fund.

On this Hon'ble Chairman directed the Government to take necessary steps as the Government is bound to provide free Medicare to the victim.

Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD assured the House that all possible help will be made.

**Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member** wanted to know the credentials of dead person of Kud, whether he was militant or a civilian.

**Mr. Javid Ahmad Mirchal, Hon'ble Member** raised the point regarding yesterday's thunderstorm due to which roofs of house were damaged in Karnah. On this **Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** stated that there is already directions with DC's for accessing the loss.

**Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member** staged a walk out.

**Mr. Qaisar Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member** that his calling attention regarding Kupwara killings has neither been listed so far nor any report submitted in the House.

### Question Hour

**Starred C.Q. Nos. 460, 440, 395, 06, 138, 19, 478, & 223** were orally answered.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 460** asked by **S. Dharambir Singh Oberoi, Hon'ble Member** regarding 24 hours power supply to metered areas and curtailment as per the schedule in non-metered areas, **Mr. Farooq Ahmad Andrabi, Hon'ble MOS for PDD** informed the House that measures will be taken to provide 24 hours power supply to metered areas.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 223** asked by **Mrs. Rani Gargi Blowria, Hon'ble Member** regarding fire incidents occurred in Mubarak Mandi Historical Complex till

date and reason for demolishing the Park and Historical Chabutra there, not satisfied with the reply Members from treasury benches pressed for constitution of **House Committee** to enquire who has taken away the items from Toshkhana. On this Chair directed that a joint House Committee be constituted to enquire fire incident & theft of Toshkhana. **On behalf of Minister for Culture, Mr. Imran Raza Ansari, Hon'ble Minister for Technical Education** also agreed to constitute joint House Committee.

**The replies of Starred C.Q.Nos. 428, 583, 688, 366, 66, 686 & 562 and Unstarred C.Q.Nos. 628, 189, 248, 521, 680, 210 & 668 were laid on the table of the House.**

**Ms. Asea Naqash, Hon'ble Minister for Urban Development** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and informed the House that Joint Commissioner Municipal Corporation has already been directed to clear the dumped garbage from the said belt and also today a team will be deputed to access the latest position of the belt.
