**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs**

**(Hon'ble Chairman Haji. Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

As soon as the House assembled for today's business **Shri. Vibod Gupta & other BJP Hon'ble Members** raised the issue regarding desecration of Shiv Temple in Nanak Nagar Jammu area by some miscreant, the Members were demanding statement on this from Government, On this **Hon'ble Chairman** tried to pacify the agitated Members but the Hon'ble Members continued their protest, **Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** stated that Government should take tough steps to curb such incidents in future. **Shri Surinder Kumar Choudhary** stated that it is big conspiracy and should be investigated. **Shri. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member** latter staged a walk out. On this **Shri. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** stated that Government is investigating the matter and whosoever is responsible, action will be taken against him. **Starred C.Q. Nos. 700, 622, 335, Clubbed C.Q. No's (182, 346, 382 & 548) were orally answered.**

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 700** asked by **Shri. Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Hon'ble Member** regarding criteria for allotment of extraction of cement from Khrew mountains by the cement manufactures, while intervening some Members wanted to know whether the policy is on hold or not.
