Point of Order

Shri. Surinder Kumar Choudhary, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding a pregnant lady namely. Reena Devi w/o Ramesh Kumar from Nowshera who was referred to Jammu, on the way at Sundarbani her condition deteriorated and was admitted in Sundarbani Hospital. No doctor was available there with the result the baby died at the time of delivery. The Hon'ble Member requested that strict action should be taken against the doctor.

Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding twin accidents that occurred in Doda & Badarwah and requested that free medical aid be provided to the victims. He also raised the issue regarding wife of employee of this secretariat presently undergoing treatment at Army Hospital Udhampur and requested that D.C Udhampur be directed to write a letter to Military Hospital Udhampur for providing proper medical facility.

Hon'ble Chairman, Haji. Anayat Ali directed the government to take necessary steps regarding the treatment of the victim.

i.e. 2010 and 2011 as well. It was also the concern of the previous government who too granted an amnesty in this regard and consequently near about 1800 youth which include teen aged also were let free. As regards the current situation, our government is also concerned with the same and is committed to release all those youth who are not involved in heinous offences and are also not found habitual of such activities. It is our primarily policy that the future of our youth either from Jammu or Kashmir who want their repartition towards peace and prosperity, be not ruined. Further, it is our endeavor to see that the youth who ignorantly indulged in such activities by this way or that way in the past, their career is not destroyed and the government is taking this issue seriously.

Language Urdu be made compulsory in all schools/educational institutions in the State upto 10th class and also in all recruitment examinations of Government/Judicial Services.

This House further recommends that the recommendations of Iqbal Khanday Committee for promotion of Urdu Language be implemented in letter and spirit."
