**(Brief Record Of Proceedings)**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11:00 Hrs**

**(Hon'ble Chairman Haji. Anayat Ali in the Chair)**

**11:00 Hrs** As soon as the **House assembled for today's business** all the Opposition members were on their feet and were demanding that Hon'ble PHE Minister should continue his further reply as they were not satisfied with yesterday's reply. They were also demanding that government should come up with a statement on Industrial Policy as directed by the Chair yesterday. **Hon'ble Chairman** tried to pacify them but they continued their protest.

**Mr. Javid Ahmad Mirchal, Hon'ble Member** raised a point regarding yesterday's accident near Sadna Pass, Karnah, District, Kupwara, in which three persons died and requested for compensation to the next kin of the victims. On this Hon'ble **Minister for Revenue, Syed Basharat Ahmad Bukhari** informed the House that concerned D.C has been directed to submit the report in this behalf.

**11:10 Hrs** **Question Hour**

**Starred Clubbed C.Q. No's. (07, 325, 438), 149, 690, Clubbed C.Q. No's. (391, 464 & 468), 649, 659, 566, 481 & 394 were orally answered.**

**Clubbed C. Q. No's (07, 325 & 438) asked by Shri. Javid Ahmad Mirchal, Shri. Showkat Hussain Ganie & Shri Vikramaditiya Singh, Hon'ble Members** regarding K.C.C Loan. On this **Mr. Gh. Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members and assured that decision will be taken within two months regarding K.C.C Loans.

**11:30 Hrs** **Point of Information**

**Shri. Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Hon'ble Member** informed the House that a delegation of Kashmiri Pandits from Hawl Pulwama approached him & informed that they are being pressurized to sell their land and requested to take preventive measures.

**C. Q. NO. 149 asked by Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** regarding Land Compensation/Cost of Trees. On this **Choudhary Lal Singh, Hon'ble Minister for Forest** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members.

**C. Q. NO. 690 asked by Mr. Ali Mohd Dar, Hon'ble Member** regarding Construction of Drain. On this **Asea Naqash, MOS for Housing & UEED** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Member and informed the House that government is very much concerned about it and will take it on priority and also stated that regarding macadamization we will take up this issue with the R&B Department.

**Clubbed C. Q. No's. (391, 464 & 468) asked by Shri. Vibod Gupta, S. Dhrambir Singh Oberoi & S. Charan Jeet Singh, Hon'ble Members** regarding Minority Commission. On this **Mr. Sajad Gani Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Social welfare** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members. As Members were not satisfied with the reply, **Members from BJP and S. Dhrambir Singh Oberoi protested and latter Shri. Vibod**

**Gupta, Hon'ble Member** staged a walk out in protest. The Chair directed that if Members are not satisfied with the reply provided by the government they can bring half an hour discussion.

**C. Q. NO. 649** asked by **Shri. Mohammad Muzaffar Paray, Hon'ble Member** regarding Public Hygiene. On this **Shri. Bali Bhagat, Hon'ble Minister for Health** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Member. **Not satisfied with the reply Hon'ble Member staged a walk out.**

**C. Q. NO. 659** asked by **Smt. Rani Gargi Blowria, Hon'ble Member** regarding purchase of Official Vehicles. On behalf of transport Minister **Mr. Sajad Gani Lone**, replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Member.

**C. Q. NO. 566** asked by **Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member** regarding Overseas Employment Corporation. **Mr. Ajay Nanda, Hon'ble MOS Labour & Employment** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members. **Mr. Zaffar Iqbal Manhas** wanted to know the persons responsible for wastage of money which was allotted to Corporation. The Members also wanted to know the present status of Corporation, whether it has been disbanded or not. While intervening **Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister** stated that government will examine it on priority and decision will be taken accordingly. Not satisfied with the reply **Dr. Shehnaz Ganai** staged a walk out.

**C. Q. NO. 481** asked by **S. Charanjeet Singh, Hon'ble Member** regarding steps taken to safe guard the Properties of Minorities. **MR. Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Member.

**C. Q. NO. 394** asked by **Shri. Vibod Gupta, Hon'ble Member** regarding granting of S.T Status To Pahari Speaking People. **Mr. Sajad Gani Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Social Welfare** replied the supplementaries raised by the Hon'ble Members and stated that report is ready and it will be sent to tribal Ministry Government of India through GAD as early as possible.

#### CALLING ATTENTION

**I) Mr. Saif-ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance that the Block Development Office, Khansahib is being constructed at a central location but CRPF has been accommodated in it, while the said office is presently housed in a deteriorated building at a far off place and the steps taken by the Government to mitigate the problems faced by the public on this score.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and stated that he will take up the matter with the concerned officers.

**II) Mr. Qaiser Jamsheed Lone, Hon'ble Member** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to delay in establishment of cancer Hospital at Kupwara, which stands already sanctioned/approved and the steps taken by the Government in this behalf.

**Shri. Bali Bhagat, Hon'ble Minister for Health** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and stated that he will personally pursue it.

**I) Dr. Shenaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** moved for leave to introduce:-

"A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004" (L.C Private Member's Bill No.10 of 2016).

**Mr. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member** seconded the Bill.

**Choudhary Zulfikar Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CA&PD** opposed the Bill.

**Dr. Shenaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** spoke on the Bill.

**Choudhary Zulfikar Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CA&PD** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and requested the Member to withdraw the Bill. Not satisfied with the reply the Hon'ble Member pressed for voting. The Bill was defeated by Voice Vote.

**II) Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** moved for leave to introduce:-

"A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Code of Criminal Procedure, Svt. 1989 (1933 A.D)" (L.C Private Member's Bill No.02 of 2016).

**Shri. Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Member** seconded the Bill.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Law** opposed the Bill.

**Shri. Naresh Kumar Gupta** spoke on the Bill.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Law** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and requested the Member to withdraw the Bill. The Bill was withdrawn by the Hon'ble Member with the permission of the House.

Bill stood **Withdrawn**.

**III) Mr. Jugal Kishore, Hon'ble Member** moved for leave to introduce:-

"A Bill to prohibit the sale of meat and liquor at Katra, the base camp of Shri. Mata Vaishno Devi and its surroundings within a radius of 12kilometers," (L.C Private Member's Bill No.04 of 2016).

**Shri. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member** seconded the Bill.

**Choudhary Zulfikar Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CA&PD** opposed the Bill.

**Mr. Jugal Kishore, Hon'ble Member** spoke on the Bill.

**Choudhary Zulfikar Ali** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and requested the Member to withdraw the Bill.

The Bill was withdrawn by the Hon'ble Member with the permission of the House.

Bill stood **Withdrawn**.

**IV) Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah (Veeri), Hon'ble Member** moved for leave to introduce:-

"A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir State Ranbir Penal Code, Svt. 1989 (1932 A.D)." (L.C Private Member's Bill No. 08 of 2016).

**Shri. Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Member** seconded the Bill.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Law** opposed the Bill.

**Dr. Bashir Ahmad Shah Veeri** spoke on the Bill.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Law** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and requested the Member to withdraw the Bill. The Bill was withdrawn by the Hon'ble Member with the permission of the House.
