As soon as the House assembled for today's Business **Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** raised an issue regarding total power shutdown in Jammu City. Which is causing severe problem to the public during the scorching heat of 40 to 43 Celsius temperatures.

Point Of Information

Mr. Ghulam Nabi Monga and Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Members raised a point regarding absence of Doordarshan and information department, **Mr. Abudul Haq Khan, Minister for RDD** assured the House that everything will run smoothly and the concerned have been informed. **Syed. Basharat Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue** said it happened because today's business started one hour earlier.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 589** asked by **Shri. G. N. Monga, Hon'ble Member** regarding invitation of Panchayat representatives to Panchayat Conferences held by RDD Minister, **Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for RDD** assured the House in future panchayat representatives will be invited and also assured the House that the Government is committed to hold panchayat elections this year. Not satisfied with the reply **Mr. G. N. Monga, Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar, Mr. Sham Lal Baghat and Dr. Shehnaz, Hon'ble Members** staged a walkout.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 333** asked by **Shri. Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Member** regarding the subjects being taught in Shopian Polytechnic College, **Mr. Sunil Kumar Sharma, Hon'ble Minister of State for Technical Education** assured the house that in view of MOU signed with the Baba Gulam Shah Badshah University the same will be examined and decision will be taken and Hon'ble Member will be informed accordingly.

Not satisfied with the reply **Hon'ble Member, Shri. Showkat Hussain Ganai** staged a walk out.

In response to **Starred C.Q.No. 545** asked by **Master Noor Hussain, Hon'ble Member** regarding the measures taken to safeguard Urdu language as an official language of the State with special reference to revenue department, while intervening **Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member** stated that some candidates who had appeared for some revenue examinations had approached Hon'ble Court against the relaxation granted in

respect of Urdu language, as Urdu is mandatory for appointment of Revenue officers and Naib Tehsildars. The Hon'ble Court has ruled in favour of the petitioners. The file for implementation of said Judgement is lying with **Hon'ble Minister for Revenue**.

On this **Syed. Basharat Ahmad Bushari, Hon'ble Minister for Revenue** Stated that one more file of identical nature is also pending and both the files will be cleared at an earliest.
