CALLING ATTENTION

- i) **SMT. RANI GARGI BLOWRIA, HON'BLE MEMBER** to call the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the encroachment of forest and State land by powerful persons, politicians and bureaucrats in State with the help of Revenue Officers/officials.
- ii) **MR. SURINDER CHOWDHARY, HON'BLE MEMBER** to call the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to power crises in Kargil district and non-availability of funds for purchase of DG sets & HS Diesel to cope up with the crises, particularly in un-electrified village of Kukshoo (Chiktan, Kargil) and the steps taken by the government in this behalf.
