BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11: 00 AM.**

**(Hon'ble Chairman Haji Anavat Ali in the chair)**

**11.00 Hrs**

As soon as House assembled, Hon'ble Members from National Conference and Mr. Gulam Nabi Monga, Hon'ble Member raised an issue regarding attack on a Kashmiri truck by some miscreants at Udhampur in which three persons were critically injured. On this, Mr. A.R Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture made a statement about the incident which took place yesterday at Udhampur. That on 09-10-2015 at about 11.45 pm a group of miscreants assembled adjacent to Hotel Dolphin near Devka and hurled a bottle containing some combustible material over a Kashmir based truck drivers which was on way from Jammu to Srinagar. Police parties under the command Deputy S.P (H.Q.R.S) and SHO Police Station, Udhampur rushed to the spot and swung into action and rescued the drivers who have got burn injuries in the said attack. The injured persons were rushed to the District Hospital, Udhampur for treatment where from they have been further referred to GMC, Jammu for specialized treatment. FIR has lodged at Police station Udhampur and further investigations are going on and a man hunt has been launched to nab the other culprits. The Hon'ble Minister assured that stern action will be taken against those who are involved. Not satisfied with the reply. Members from NC and Shri G.N. Monga Hon'ble Member staged a walkout.

#### **ZERO HOUR**

*Dr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri, Hon'ble Member* raised the issue of daily wagers, Casual labours working in different departments of the State and requested to Government that their problems be solved and their wages be released.

*Mr. Khursheed Alam, Hon'ble Member* raised the issue of encroachment of Grave yard Malkah and demanded that the said Grave yard be saved from encroachments and restoration of dignity of graveyard & nearby Fort.

*Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member* raised the issue of unemployment created due to completion and closure of power projects in the region.

*Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member* raised the issue of withdrawal of security from Ex-Legislators and other political workers and demanded Government should consider the issue seriously as there are some threat perceptions.

*Mr. Vibodh Gupta, Hon'ble Member* raised the issue of KPS Officers and demanded that they be brought at par with KAS officers.

*Mr. Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Hon'ble Member* raised the issue regarding saffron growers and requested that the subsidy be provided to remaining 350 saffron growers.

**Mr. Saif-ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue of stopping of work on Sukhnag Power Project due to non-availability of funds and also demanded that Waterhal- Arizal Power Grid be completed before winter.

**Mr. Vikramaditya Singh, Hon'ble Member** demanded that Health Department should establish Rehabilitation Centers for drug addicts. On this Ch. Lal Singh Hon'ble Minister for Health stated that since it comes under the ambit of Narcotic Act which falls within the jurisdiction of Police.

**Mr. Zafar Manhas Iqbal, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue of 5% Reservation Quota in favour of Pahari Speaking and requested to appoint Chairman for Backward Class Commission.

**Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding construction of Bridge at Kuchpora, Soitang and requested the work will be expedited.

**Mr. Surinder Choudhary, Hon'ble Member** demanded the reservation for the people of Border areas facing the shelling from across the Border.

**Mr. Jugal Kishore, Hon'ble Member** demanded work on Bomyal to Deva Mai, Katra which was started in 2006 be completed.

**Mr. Ghulam Nabi Monga, Hon'ble Member** demanded completion of Jati Bridge and requested that special funds be provided.

**Miss Shehnaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue of Media persons running unapproved News papers and stated that empanelling Committee has been framed six months back but no meeting of the said committee was held resulting in non publishing of Government adds in these newspapers resulting in hardships to them, and also difficulty in running the news papers.

**Mr. Ramesh Arora, Hon'ble Member** demanded that encroachment of State land at Golf-Course, Jammu and at other places be removed.

**Mr. Yasir Rishi, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue of recent incident which occurred at MLA's Hostel and demanded to expose those who wants to spoil the peace in the State.

**Mr. Jehangir Hussain Mir, Hon'ble Deputy Chairman** stated that it is the prime responsibility of each & every one to maintain peace and harmony in the state.

**CALLING ATTENTION**

- i) **SMT. RANI GARGI BLOWRIA, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the encroachment of forest and State land by powerful persons, politicians and bureaucrats in State with the help of Revenue Officers/officials.

**Mr. Sunil Sharma, Hon'ble MOS for Revenue** replied the points raised by Hon'ble Member.

- ii) **MR. SURINDER CHOWDHARY, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to power crises in Kargil district and non-availability of funds for purchase of DG sets & HS Diesel to cope up with the crises, particularly in un-electrified village of Kukshoo (Chiktan, Kargil) and the steps taken by the government in this behalf.

**Mohammad Ashraf Mir, Hon'ble MOS Power** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and *assured the House* that one DG set will be provided.

- iii) **MR. MOHAMMAD KHURSHID ALAM HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the pendency of SRO-43 cases in Deputy Commissioner's Office, Srinagar, since last ten years and steps taken in this behalf.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development Department** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

- iv) **DR. SHEHNAZ GANAI, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely the situation that has arisen due to pathetic condition of the Media Complex at Poonch.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development Department** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and *assured the House* that the matter will be brought to the notice of DC and steps will be taken to get the building vacated at the earliest.

- v) **MR. ZAFAR IQBAL MANHAS, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to dilapidated condition of internal roads in Kargil, especially in Tambis, Kanoor (TSG Block) Wakha Mulabek & Shergoal (Shergoal Block) and the steps taken

by the government to improvise the roads network in order to ease the problems being faced by the people of the area.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development Department** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member & *assured* that Chief Engineer R&B will be asked to take on spot assessment..

- vi) **MR. QAISER JAMSHEED LONE, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to cultivation of Bang crop in the forest land at Trumkhan, Dewar, Lolab Kupwara.

**Mr. Bali Bhagat, Hon'ble Minister for Forests** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member and *assured the House* that a special team will be deputed there for on-spot assessment and action will taken against the persons responsible for cultivating the narcotic substance (Bung).

#### **POINT OF INFORMATION**

*Shri Showkat Hussain Ganai, Hon'ble Member* informed that there is a rumor that the person injured in last nights attack at Udhampur has died and sought information from Government on this Shri Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister stated that he will collect the same and share with House.

- vii) **DR. BASHIR AHMAD SHAH VEERI, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance, namely, the situation that has arisen after flood in and around village Auder, which is cut off from all sides and work on foot bridge (ropeway) was under progress through RDD, which has been stopped altogether.

**Mr. Abdul Haq Khan, Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development Department** replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Member.

*Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development Department Mr. Abdul Haq Khan* informed the House that injured person has not died but is still under treatment.
