BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11: 00 AM.

(Hon'ble Chairman Haji Anayat Ali in the chair)

As soon as House assembled, *Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo* and other Hon'ble Members raised Point of Information regarding death of Raj Kumar NYC youth during hunger strike and were demanding reply from Government. Hon'ble Chairman directed the Hon'ble Members take their seats and raise the issue after Question Hour, Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture made a statement about the death of the said person and stated the NYC youth was a private school teacher was having chest pain and died due to cardiac arrest and was not part of strike.

QUESTION HOUR

Starred C.Q. No's. 57, 119, 166, 255 & 211 were orally answered.

While replying to *Starred C.Q. No. 166 asked by Shri Surinder Kumar Choudhary Hon'ble Member* regarding allotment of shops. *Mr. Mohammad Ashraf Mir, Hon'ble MOS for Housing assured the House* that a committee has been constituted for investigating illegal allotment of shops, report of the said committee has not been received till date as soon as report of the committee is received action will be taken and Rules will be followed.

In response to *Starred C.Q. No. 119* regarding detention under PSA etc. *Shri Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture assured the House* that cases of Kishtwar youth will be looked into and action will be taken against Drug Peddlers as per law.

In response to *Starred C.Q. No. 211* asked by Shri Firdous Ahmad Tak regarding KPS Officers, *Shri. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture assured the House* that there is disparity regarding service rules of KPS officers. The proposal of removal disparity is under examination in the Home department, and the issue will be considered by the Government.

Starred C.Q. No's. 266, 15 and Un-starred Questions 131, 277, 36, 112, 177, and 63 were laid on the table of the House.

Dr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri, Hon'ble Member raised Short Notice Questions regarding continuous closer of Jamia Masjid Check-i-Jaffar in Mud Block, Jammu which was replied by *Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture on behalf of Minister incharge Relief and Rehabilitation.*

Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Hon'ble Member raised the issue regarding non-supplying of reply to his question.

Hon'ble Chairman informed the Hon'ble Member that directions has been given to the concerned department to furnish the reply to the Member.

Mr. Vibodh Gupta, Hon'ble Member demanded that power supply, water supply be made available during Navratra Festival.

SMT. POINT OF INFORMATION

Mr. Gulam Nabi Monga, and Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo Hon'ble Members informed the House that students were selected under PM scholarship scheme out side the state have been directed either to deposit fee or vacate the college as scholarship has not been released so far. On this, *Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture* informed that whenever scholarship is released the fee deposited by students will be returned to them.

CALLING ATTENTION

MR. SURINDER MOHAN AMBARDAR, HON'BLE MEMBER called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the unnecessary police verification being conducted at Jagti township, Muthi, Buta Nagar, Purkhoo (Migrant Colonies) due to which displaced communities are facing unnecessary harassment and hardships.

Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture on behalf of Hon'ble Home Minister replied the points and assured that directions will be given to IGP (CID) for proper investigation of the matter and not to harass inmates there.

LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

Bill for consideration and pass.

SYED BASHARAT AHMAD BUKHARI, HON'BLE MINISTER FOR LAW, JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, moved that :-

“ Bill to amend Jammu and Kashmir Legal Services Authorities Act, 1977 (L.A Bill No. 7 of 2015) be taken into consideration.

Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture seconded the Bill.

The Hon'ble Chairman put the Motion for consideration of the House which was adopted by voice vote.

Thereafter, Mr. Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Law, Justice & Parliamentary Affairs moved that the Bill be passed.

The Motion was put to vote and passed by voice vote.

The Bill stood accordingly passed.

Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture on behalf of JENAB MUFTI MOHAMMAD SYED, HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER moved that :-

“ A Bill to provide for the regulation of Private security agencies operating in the State of jammu and Kashmir and for the matters connected their with or incidental thereto (L.A. Bill No. 8 of 2015) be taken into consideration.

SYED BASHARAT AHMAD BUKHARI, HON'BLE MINISTER FOR LAW, JUSTICE AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, seconded the Bill.

Hon'ble Chairman put the Motion for consideration of the House and following Hon'ble Members spoke on the Bill.

Mr. Gulam Nabi Monga, Mr. Firdous Ahmad Tak, Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Mr. Ramesh Arora & Mr. Surinder Choudhary.

Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Members and assured that the suggestion of the Hon'ble Members will be taken care while framing Rules and also stated that amendments if any required will brought at any time before the House after passing of the Bill.

The Motion was considered and adopted by voice vote.

Thereafter, Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister moved that Bill be returned.

The Bill was accordingly returned.
