**BULLETIN Part -1ST
TUESDAY 6th of OCTOBER, 2015
BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**

The council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11: 00 AM.

(Hon'ble Chairman Haji Anayat Ali in the chair)

11.00 Hrs

The House assembled for today's business, all the Hon'ble Members from opposition stood up from their seats and were demanding adequate ration supply be provided to the people of State & also safeguard of *Article 35A*. Hon'ble Chairman tried to pacify the agitated Members and asked them to take their respective seats and bring Motion for half an hour discussion, but the Hon'ble Members continued their protest & created a din in the House

11.25 Hrs

Ch. Zulfiqar Ali, Hon'ble Minister for CAPD moved that *Mr. Showkat Ahmad Ganai & Mr. Ali Mohammad Dar Hon'ble Members* be suspended under rules for creating ruckus in the House. Hon'ble Chairman suspended both of them for rest of the session & directed that these Hon'ble Members be Marshal out.

QUESTION HOUR

Starred C.Q. No's 232, 60, 100, 254, 165, 274, 144, 194, 262, 175 and 40 were orally answered.

In response to *Starred C.Q. No. 60* asked by *Mr. Ramesh Arora* regarding Mathwar –Katra road *Mr. Sunil Sharma Hon'ble MOS R&B* assured that double laning of said road will be considered.

Un-starred C.Q. No's 16, 51, 240, 67, 25, 122, 228, 159, 07, 128, 257, 88, 140, 213, 205 and 185 were laid on the table of the House.

ZERO HOUR

The following Hon'ble Members raised various issues during ZERO HOUR.

Mr. Vibod Gupta raised the issue of non-conducting of interviews by SSRB in Jammu especially Physical teachers for Rajouri and also demanded daily wagers, NYC casual labours under MGNREGA be regularized and also demanded that status of Migrants to the persons of No man's land (Border) who residing in Nowshera be granted.

Mr. Surinder Chowdhary raised the issue of casual labours of PHE who are demanding regularization and requested that negotiation be started with them.

Mr. Ajat Shutru Singh demanded that Critical Care Ambulances be kept ready & Heli service for accidental victims. He further demanded that over loading be checked & ban on old vehicles be imposed.

Mr. Surinder Mohan Ambardar demanded that status of RBA category be restored for KPS (Kashmiri Pandits).

Firdous Ahmad Tak demanded that Ration Supply be provided to Chenab Valley especially Kishtwar before the blockage of roads.

Mr. Sofi Yousf demanded decongestion of traffic jam at Panthachowk & also that monthly honorarium of SPO's be enhanced from Rs. 3000/- to 6000/-.

Mr. Ramesh Arora raised the issue of variation in distribution of Ration at some places @ Rs. 25 kg and some placed @ Rs. 35 kg and non availability of life saving equipments in Hospitals of Jammu.

Mr. Ashok Khajuria demanded Town planning of Jammu city be made as per escalated population & rise in number of vehicles.

Mr. Khursheed Alam demanded regularization of Casual labours in different departments.

Mr. Charanjet Singh raised the issue regarding shortage of Punjabi Language teachers in the State and demanded posting of Punjabi teachers.

Mr. Vikramaditya Singh demanded that migrants of Talwara be brought at par with Kashmiri Pandit migrants.

Mr. Saif Ud Din Bhat raised the issue of registration of migrants in 1990 & demanded the probe be held to look into the fake registration.

Shri Ajat Shatru Singh Hon'ble Member pointed that as per rule only one issue be raised during *Zero Hour*.

Mr. Zafar Iqbal Manhas raised the issue regarding granting of 5% reservation to Pahari speaking people.

Mr. Yasir Reshi raised the issue regarding issuance of fake appointment orders and demanded that FIR be registered against erring officers & Political persons. On *this Syed Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Law and Parliamentary Affairs* stated that if Hon'ble Member has some knowledge about this he should identify the same and action will be taken against those responsible persons.
