BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11: 00 AM.**

**(Hon'ble Chairman Haji Anayat Ali in the chair)**

**11.00 Hrs**

**POINT OF ORDER**

**Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta and Mr. G.N. Monga, Hon'ble Members** requested the Chair that suspension order of Mr. Ali Mohd. Dar and Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganie, Hon'ble Members be revoked.

**Dr. Nirmal Singh, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister** also requested the Chairman for revocation of suspension order of both the Hon'ble MLC'S.

**Hon'ble Chairman** revoked the order on the request of Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister and other Hon'ble Member's.

**Hon'ble Members** from the Congress Party were protesting regarding Hike in Power Tariff and Chopper Tax, Hon'ble Chairman tried to pacify them but they continued their protest and not satisfied with Chair staged walk out.

**QUESTION HOUR**

***Starred C.Q. No's. 41, 173, 191, 145, 163, 251, 82, 182 and 47 were orally answered.***

In response to *Starred C.Q. No. 191* asked by *Mr. Vikramaditya Singh* regarding expansion of Jammu Airport , while intervening *Hon'ble Chief Minister assured the House* Jammu airport will be upgraded on priority basis and efforts will be made by the Government by taking the issue with Government of India and making it at par with Srinagar airport. The Army has agreed to vacate the land and the Government will provide them the alternative land on fast track basis.

In response to *C.Q. No 145* asked by *Mr. Vibod Gupta* Hon'ble Member regarding appointments through SSRB and PSC, while intervening *Hon'ble Chief Minister assured the House* that appointments will be made on fast track basis and transparency will be maintained. He further stated that this Government has not made any backdoor appointment from the day it took over.

In response to *C.Q. No. 82* asked by *Mr. Ajat Shrutru Singh* Hon'ble Member regarding up-gradation of lakes in Jammu *Hon'ble Chief Minister assured the House* that Surinsar and Sanasar will be upgraded as best Tourist destinations in Jammu.
