BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**

**The Council met in the Council Hall, Srinagar at 11: 00 AM.**

**(Hon'ble Chairman Haji Anayat Ali in the chair)**

**11.00 Hrs**

The House assembled for today's business and Members from Congress Party raised a point of order regarding the establishment of AIIM's at Jammu as well as Kashmir as no notification has been issued so far and about the disturbance at Udhampur for the last two weeks. The Members from Congress Party staged walk out .

**QUESTION HOUR**

*Starred C.Q. No's.111, 92, 05, 14, 82, 83 and 84 were orally answered.*

**11.30 Hrs**

In response to *Starred C.Q NO 111* asked by *Showkat Hussain Ganai Hon'ble Member* regarding construction of roads and e-tendering. *Mr. Altaf Ahamd Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Works assured the House* that if any body is found guilty action will be taken against him.

**POINT OF INFORMATION**

**Mr. Yasir Rishi, Hon'ble Member** informed that only one machine for removing yarn from sheeps is available which is not sufficient & demanded more machines at Bandipora.

In response to *C.Q. No. 5* asked by *Shri Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member* regarding *RGGVY scheme* while making *supplementary* *Mr. Jugal Kishore Sharma, Hon'ble Member* informed that he provided Rs. 30 lacs out of CDF for the electrification of Machail area but neither the work has been executed nor any

account has been rendered to him. **Dr. Nirmal Singh Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister** assured the House that he will examine the matter.

Due to paucity of time **clubbed Starred C.Q. No's. viz 203, 134, 117, 58, 275,49, 102** asked by **Mr. Ghulam Nabi Monga, Dr. Shehnaz Ganai, Mr. Qaiser Jamshed Lone, Mr. Ramesh Arora, Mr. Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Mr. Charanjeet Singh & Sofi Yousuf** Hon'ble Members regarding flood victims was not discussed and on this **Dr. Shehnaz Ganai** Hon'ble Member staged a walkout.

**Starred C.Q. No's. (Clubbed- 189, 282, 283 ) 263, 242, (Clubbed- 190, 81 ) 146, 164, 70, 253 & Un-starred C. Q. No's. 113, 96, 27, 247, 66, 09, 267, 239, 37, 149, 256, 130, 160, 87, 207, 53, 114, 215, 126, 231 & 121** were laid on the table of the House.

### **ZERO HOUR**

#### **12.00 Hrs**

**MR. Vibodh Gupta, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding delay in selection list of Technical Education Teachers and inter district transfer of female teachers including RET's.

**Mr. Bashir Ahmad Veeri, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding transportation of fruit to different mandi's of the country alleging charging of high rates & blackmailing by the transporters. On this, **Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Horticulture** assured the House that matter will be sorted out.

**Mr. Naresh Kumar Gupta, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding the establishment of National Institute of Medicinal Plants Bharderwah as land was also identified but the work on the institute has not been initiated till date.

**Mr. Surinder Mohan Ambardar, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue of dilapidated condition of temples/shrines and demanded for framing of Shrine Bill.

**Mr. Surinder Choudhary, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue of families whose houses were damaged in Nowshera due to devastating flash floods of 2014, and demanded compensation to the affected families, farmers and restoration of damaged roads including widening of roads maintained by BRO & GREF.

**Dr. Shehnaz Ganai, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue of establishment of Degree College at Mandi Poonch.

**Mr. Jugal Kishore, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding share from the income of the shrine Board to the families of Pujaris and Brahmins affected due to establishment of Shrine Board in 1986.

**Mr. Zafar Iqbal Manhas, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding granting of 5% reservation to Pahari Speaking people & also demanded to appoint Chairman for Backward Class Commission.

**Mr. Ghulam Nabi Monga, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding established of AIIMS in Kashmir and requested to the government to issue the notification in this regard.

**Mr. Sajad Ahmad Kichloo, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding distribution of 18 thousands Solar lights in Marva Kishtwar.

**Mr. Saif-ud-Din Bhat, Hon'ble Member** raised the issue regarding dedicating the Srinagar Airport on the name of Sheikh-ul-Alam, the BJP Members supported the issue and suggested that it should named as Nund Reshi International Airport.

**Mr. Ghulam Nabi Lone, Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture** informed the House that Resolution was adopted by this House some time back on the same subject matter and the name of the Airport was recommended as Sheikh-Ul-Alam, International Airport.

**RESOLUTION MOVED**

**Mr. Naeem Akhter Andrabi, (Leader of the House) Hon'ble Minister for Education** moved that this House unanimously resolves to reiterate the firm and unshakable faith of the people of Jammu and Kashmir in its age old tradition of secularism, pluralism and tolerance. The Resolution was unanimously adopted by the voice vote.

### **CALLING ATTENTION**

i) **MR. GHULAM NABI MONGA, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to damage to crops and properties of people due to heavy rains in Ladakh and the steps taken by the Government to provide relief and rehabilitation to the effected people.

*Mr. Basharat Ahmad Bukhari, Hon'ble Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs* replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Members.

ii) **MR. VIBOD GUPTA, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the dilapidated condition of Hamilton and Abdullah bridges connecting well populated areas to Rajouri town and the steps taken by the Government to ease traffic flow through these bridges by double laning them.

*Mr. Abdul Rehman Veeri, Hon'ble Minister for Haj & Auqaf* replied the points raised by the Hon'ble Members.

iii) **MR. SURINDER MOHAN AMBARDAR, HON'BLE MEMBER** called the attention of the government towards a matter of urgent public importance namely, the situation that has arisen due to the supply of contaminated water at Jagti township/Muthi/Buta Nagar Camps and steps taken by the Government in this behalf.
