

Vide Government Order No. 68-Edu(Tech) of 2005 dated 16.05.2005 accorded adoption of State Policy declaring Sports, Games and Physical Education Compulsory in all Middle Schools, High Schools & Hr. Sec. Schools in the State since session 2005-06. In order to implement the Government Order in letter & spirit, a committee of officers comprising members from Directorate of Education Jammu/Kashmir, J&K BOSE and Youth Services & Sports Department was constituted. The said committee finalized the syllabus from 6th to 10th classes and submitted to Chairman J&K BOSE for issuance of notification.

At present Physical Education subject is being taught at 10+2 level in various Hr. Sec. Schools in the State where services of Physical Education Lecturer has been provided. However, in order to implement Sports and Physical Education as compulsory subject, the department has to provide trained man-power in all the schools from the base level of Middle schools.

The department has received a proposal from Director General, Youth Services & Sports, J&K on 22.03.2015 in which the Directorate has requested to create 5931 posts of Physical Education Teachers for uncovered Middle Schools and proposal is under active consideration of the department.

Since the creation of posts involves financial implication, the matter is under examination in the department and shortly being submitted to the Planning & Finance Departments for consideration.
