a	Whether is it a fact that a large number of technically and professionally qualified youth are going out of the State for job opportunities causing quality human resource loss to the State;	Yes sir. Some technically and professionally qualified youth do migrate out of State for better remunerations. But, this worldwide phenomenon and not peculiar to J&K State only. Though there is apparently loss of human resource, but it gets compensated by immigration of quality man power from outside especially in Centrally run projects. In the world of IT/Communication revolution, quality manpower is now not an entirely a stationary peg, but fluid and can be capitalized from any part of the world.
b	Whether is it also a fact that there are still large number of technically and professional qualified youth within the state who are either underemployed or unemployed;	There are 9803 technically and professionally qualified unemployed youth registered with District Employment and Couseling Centres of the State The registration is voluntary process, the figures may be higher.
c	Is there any plan to attract large manufacturing industries, service sector and IT companies to the state so that quality manpower is retained within the state?	<p>The J&K Govt. has issued the New Industrial Policy vide Govt. Order No. 58 IND of 2016 dated:15.03.2016 with the following features to attract large manufacturing Industries, Service Sector, & IT companies to the State so that quality man power is retained within the State:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> I. Creation of a land bank for development of well provided industrial estates and industry specific industrial parks, clusters, growth centres etc in Public Sector and through PPP. II. Special focus on Thrust Industries like IT And IT enabled services- Hardware/Software(BPO/Call Centres), Hi-Tech(Consumer Electronics, Telecom, Solar Photo, Voltaic System, VLSI/Chip etc)- and other Industrial clusters like Food Parks, Export Processing and Export Promotion Parks, Pharmaceutical Clusters etc. III. Attractive financial incentives of the State Government and that of the Special Central Package coupled with prompt sanction and timely disbursement of the said incentives. IV. Providing improved infrastructure and support services with emphasis on regular and uninterrupted power supply, Telecom/Internet connectivity within the existing and new industrial estates/parks/growth centres, logistics, warehousing etc. V. The State Government shall encourage skill development and technically training of the youth by the empanelled and reputed technical training institutes in activities where the skill base and technical expertise is deficient in the State. VI. Ease of Doing Business through simplification of procedures

	<p>and rules across various departments.</p> <p>VII. Enabling manufacture of quality consistent products through brand promotion, modernization and quality certification.</p> <p>VIII. Entrepreneurship training and Human Resource Development for capacity building of the educated unemployed youth.</p> <p>IX. Human Resource Development:- The State Government shall encourage imparting technical training by the industrial units on the pattern of apprenticeship scheme. some financial assistance will be provided to the industrial unit to partially offset the training cost and a small stipend paid to the trainees.</p> <p>X. Entrepreneur and Skill Development Fund:-An entrepreneur and skill development fund shall be created for incorporating entrepreneurial skills to the local youths for sustained industrial growth in the state. 10% of the premium charged by SIDCO for allotment of the land to the entrepreneurs shall be transferred to this Fund.</p> <p>XI. Reservation of plots in Industrial Estates:-There is a provision for reservation of land /plots in the Estates developed by the SIDCO/SICOP having more than 1500 Kanals of area to the:-</p> <p>XII. Women Entrepreneurs/Start-ups - 10%</p> <p>XIII. Micro and Small Enterprises/Start-ups - 10%</p> <p>XIV. Encouraging Research & Development (R&D) for industrial applications.</p> <p>XV. Suitable steps for establishment of Green Corridor/Inland Container Depot/Rail Freight Corridors.</p> <p>XVI. Environmental protection to conform to the State and national standards by encouraging setting up of green industries and adoption of green technology.</p> <p>XVII. Inviting reputed industrial houses and potential investors from within and outside the State to promote the State as an ideal investment destination.</p> <p>XVIII. Apex Committee under the Chief Secretary, High Level Monitoring Committee (HLMC) under the Administrative Secretary of Industries and Commerce for ease of doing business.</p> <p>The various IT companies/vendors are engaged to implement more than 20 IT related project in the State. This provides some employment to IT professionals in the State.</p>
